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Introduction

The study of Enoch's testimony in Hebrews 6:12, Is one of the ways to discover more about Yahweh and to advance in the kingdom. We would come to realise the two scripturally recommended ways to spiritual development. Number one, is to seek direct encounters with Yahweh through His word and the ministry of the Holy Spirit. And number two, is to follow closely and learn from people who have gone before, whether historically or still alive.

Hebrews 6:12 says, "Ye be not slothful, but followers of them," so there are some people who are worth following, "who through faith and patience inherit the promises." The Bible tells us not to be slothful and to follow those who inherit the promise through faith and patience. One of the ways we press towards the things of Yahweh and progress spiritually is by looking for role models and references who have given their lives to capture the numerous dimensions of Yahweh.

Abraham

For example, Abraham is a recommended character to study if you want to learn about what it means to be blessed in the Kingdom without losing your soul. "Look unto Abraham your father and to Sarah that bare you; for I called him alone, and I blessed him, and I increased him." That is, if your strategy for being prosperous is not in the order of Abraham, you will experience failure and disaster. There are many other aspects of prosperity, but the scripturally defined path that defines a blessed man is Abraham's.

If you would like to have an encounter with the God of Heaven, an encounter that transforms you, then the recommended personality to emulate and learn the things he has done with Yahweh is Jacob. Psalms 24:3-4 says, "Who shall ascend to the hill of the Lord and who shall stand in his holy place"? "He that has clean hands and a pure heart; who has not lifted his soul unto vanity; nor sworn deceitfully." That he will receive a blessing from the Lord and even righteousness from the God of his salvation.

"This is the generation (verse 6) of them that seek him, that seek thy face." "God of Jacob" is what the original version says. One of the benefits of catching a dimension of Yahweh in your life is that Yahweh will rename you in honour of your devotion. If you walk with Yahweh according to His statutes, you should be able to say, "You are the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob." Not as a religious rite but as part of your personal experience with Yahweh, which you are leaving behind to share with the unborn generation.

Touching The Matter Of Faith

We were unaware of the identity of Abraham's God until he began to walk peculiarly with Yahweh. I hope you are aware of how the God of Abraham and the God of Isaac function differently. In the

same way, you have seven spirits and seven operations, but it is still the same spirit. If you are studying faith, according to scripture, you refer to Abraham, and even in the New Testament, you come to the Apostle Peter and learn about Yeshua when it pertains to matters of faith.

"Satan had the desire to sift you like wheat", he says "but I have prayed for you that your faith fails not, and when you are converted (now with this knowledge) strengthen your brethren." When you want to study someone who is the embodiment of favour in Scripture, you must read the complete Book of Esther. The book was written in the name of a woman, and although never used a weapon, she defeated everyone who was an Antichrist. There you learn about favour.

Touching The Matter Of Deliverance

The book of Exodus as written by Moses depicts "The Life and the Exodus of Israel in Egypt" is a must-read for anybody interested in learning about deliverance. The complete journey, including the promised land, is the most succinct description of a people's deliverance. Romans 15:4. "For whatsoever things were written aforetime," the Bible says, "were written for our learning, that we, through patience and the comfort of the scriptures, might have hope."

What this means is, that it is not unscriptural to isolate biblical characters and study them to learn from their lives, experiences, and aspects of Yahweh that will help us grow and prosper in the kingdom. Therefore, we will study the man, Enoch.

Chapter One

Enoch

Genesis 5 has the first presentation of this man, Enoch. There was the first Enoch, who was Cain's son; this is not the one we are discussing. The Bible reveals important information about this man named Enoch in Genesis 5:18. "And Jared lived a hundred sixty and two years, and he begat Enoch." So, Enoch was a man who was physically born of earthly origin, with Jared as his father. According to Genesis 5:21, "And Enoch lived sixty and five years, and he begot Methuselah."

So, we can see that Enoch was a human being in every way; he had a son, Methuselah, who, according to the Bible, was the longest-living man documented in Scripture. When you study through the genealogies written in the Bible, you will find out that Enoch was the great-grandfather of Noah. Jude 1:14: "And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam." Now, I do not mean to create any controversy here, but did you notice the Bible never said the seven from creation? It said the seventh from Adam because, even before Adam, that is another story. So, the counting for our dispensation begins with Adam, who was the first man created in the image and likeness of Yahweh.

The Genesis account

If you wish to learn more about creation, read the Book of Job and explore Job's contemplations amid his sorrow. He began a discourse with Yahweh, and as He began to communicate wisdom, He informed us how the earth was formed and how the sons of Yahweh sang for joy, which is not recorded in Genesis. "In the beginning, Yahweh created heaven and earth. And the Earth was without form and void, and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of Yahweh moved upon the face of the waters." From a theological perspective, it is known as the Gap Theory.

It attempts to explain what happened from the beginning of creation as we know it, as described in Scripture. This darkness and chaos are derived from the Hebrew words for confusion and chaos, which signify that something has happened. We see the contrast between Genesis 1:1-2 because Yahweh's creation is characterised by the requirement that whatever He produces is good. Chaos has now taken over, indicating that something has happened.

Theologically speaking, Genesis 1:3 refers to the re-creation of Earth rather than the first creation. Therefore, our dispensation—what you refer to as eternity or dispensations—is not the first mentioned in the Bible. The Earth is barely a little above or a little close to six thousand years old, as we know from Adam. However, scientists have discovered ancient sites that go back tens of thousands of years, and they have managed to carbonate rocks. Is that true? That tells you there

is more than we know.

But the Bible says that what is sufficient for us are the things that are already written for our learning. That means you do not need to feel bad that you do not know certain things; all you need to know is that Yahweh can be found within the volume of that which is written. So, the blind search for things that are not written is not necessary. He says that whatever you are trying to find in the things that are not written can be found by the Spirit in the things that are already written.

Learning scripture is sufficient, in partnership with the Holy Spirit, to help believers learn about Yahweh to the fullest. As far as knowing Yahweh in this phase of life is concerned.

Biography Of Enoch

So, returning to Enoch, the Bible teaches us in Jude 1:14 that he was the seventh man from Adam and prophesied that certain things would happen. A quick recap of Enoch. Number one, he was Jared's son. In Genesis 5:18, he is mentioned twice as the father of Methuselah. In Genesis 5:21, he was also Noah's great-grandfather. He was the seventh man from Adam. He lived for 365 years before Yahweh took him. Three key facts regarding Enoch that concern us. Number one can be found in Genesis 5:22-24: "And Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah 300 years and begat sons and daughters.

Despite his ordinary life, the Bible isolates that man and provides us with crucial information: that he walked with Yahweh. As if the rest of humanity did not walk with Yahweh, why would the Bible separate this individual from the rest of humanity? Noah walked with Yahweh, as did several other people, but there was something peculiar about Enoch's walk with Yahweh. The Bible needed to isolate and repeat that experience twice. According to Genesis 5:24, "And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for Yahweh took him."

This is powerful: he walked with Yahweh. He walked with Yahweh while bearing children and enjoying his normal daily human life. He even went so far as to walk with Yahweh that he never experienced the sensation of normal death, which adds another dimension to the story. For Yahweh took him. We must first determine who took him, as there is much to learn about Enoch. If the Bible fails to clarify who took him, we can assume he backslid, something happened, or he vanished.

However, the Bible states that Yahweh took him, thus we can be certain of his fate. Any information written about him for our education can be trusted. Enoch walked with Yahweh, which is information number one. Number two, the second knowledge regarding Enoch, can be found in Hebrews 11:5. "By faith, Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because Yahweh had translated him."

The Testimony Of Enoch

Watch this now because he had this testimony before he was translated. Not that he lived a long life; nor that he was a prophet who correctly predicted the future; or that he had numerous children, one of whom became the longest-living man. There were many more great testimonials, but Paul is speaking to the Hebrews. And he tells them that he has a testament that he pleased Yahweh. What a testimony! The second fact concerning him was that he testified that he pleased God. Number three is seen in Jude 1:14-25. According to the Bible, "And Enoch also the seventh from Adam prophesied," indicating that he was more than just a family man.

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He prophesied, "Behold the Lord cometh with ten thousand of his saints, to execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds that they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him. These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their lusts, and their mouths speak great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage." Look at what this guy was prophesying.

Prophesying The End Times

"But beloved, remember yourselves the words which were spoken before of the apostles of the Lord Jesus Christ "How they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the spirit. But ye beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life."

And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garments spotted by the flesh: "Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding Joy, "To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power both now and forever amen. Jude 1:18-25.

So, we can see that a reference was made to Enoch's prophecy. He cautioned his generation therefore we need to learn from him; the Bible states two extremely essential things about him. Number one, he walked with Yahweh until he obtained a testimony that he pleased Yahweh. And number two we see him prophesying, warning his generation about decadence, and leading them to righteousness. The pursuit of the one true God is Enoch's testimony.

Chapter Two

What Does It mean And What Does It Take To Walk With God?

When people pass away in most graveyards and burial grounds, they leave an epitaph that summarises their life. Something that they accomplished during their lifetime, perhaps he or she was a good politician, an entrepreneur, or just lived and blessed people. They will write something. Just knowing that this man, a witness, accomplished one of the most remarkable things, should give you hope. According to the Bible, if you remember Enoch for anything other than being the father of Methuselah, "You must keep this testimony in mind: he walked with Yahweh and he pleased Yahweh."

There are two question we need to address. If we could effectively answer these questions, we would have genuinely understood and assimilated Enoch's testimony into our own spiritual experience. Question one: What does it mean, and what does it take to walk with Yahweh? The first thing we must address is why the Bible claims that Enoch walked with God. If you want to have that kind of witness during your lifetime and after your life, you must be able to read scripture and understand what it means to walk with Yahweh.

How To Experience The Kingdom

Yeshua's explanation in Matthew 19:13 provides the answer to the question. "Then were they brought unto him little children, that he should put his hands on them and pray, and the disciples rebuked them." Just as the disciples prepare to take the children away, there is an instant rebuke. But Jesus said, suffer little children, and forbid them not. "The word suffer means to permit, to allow, "and forbid them not to come unto me." He adds there is a lesson to be learned from their lives, "For such the kingdom."

That indicates there is a state that a young child possesses that until you achieve that state, you will be unable to walk in the experience of the kingdom. When you see young children approaching me, he says, use them as a lesson to understand something about what it takes to experience the Kingdom, rather than being preoccupied with following protocol and turning them away. Verse 15 says, "And he laid his hands on them and departed hence.

And behold, one came and said unto him, good master, what good thing shall I do so that I may have eternal life? He comes to meet Yeshua now, and Yeshua replies, "And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God but if thou will enter into life, keep the commandments." "He saith unto him which? Jesus said, thou shall do no murder, thou shall not commit adultery, thou shall not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and thou shall love thy neighbour as thyself."

"The young man saith unto him all these I have kept from my youth up: what lack I yet?" Now here is the test: "Yeshua said unto him if thou wilt be perfect." You have tried, but I see that you desire a deeper level. This is the next condition. "Go and sell that thou hast, and give it to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven; once you have done so, come and follow me. You desire to walk with me and follow me; do not follow me with those things.

The prerequisite is as follows: Sell everything that has the potential to take my place in your life. When you are empty of them, when you are prepared to be empty, he says, "Come and follow me."

A Forsaking

Watch what happened to the young man. He was alright. "But when the young man heard this saying, he went away sad." Why? Because he has many great possessions. Yeshua saw him going sorrowfully and remarked, "Truly, I say unto you, a rich man shall hardly enter the kingdom of heaven. Again, I say to you, it is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God. When his disciples heard it, they were astounded, asking, who can be saved?" If they had been destitute, the statement would not have concerned them; instead, something he said touched them.

They said no, no hold on what is this you just said "Who then can be saved" but Jesus beheld them and said with men this is impossible but With God, all things are possible. "Then answered Peter and said unto him, Behold. We have forsaken all." Pay close attention to what Yeshua said to the man. He said, "Follow me, if you want to walk with me; there has to be a forsaken; You have to sell some things" It is not like you turned liquidity into cash and then hung onto it; rather, He was establishing a principle that states, "You cannot follow me until you are empty of all that signifies your worth."

Then Peter said, "Okay, what you are saying, we have done it already; behold, we have forsaken all and followed you; what shall we have, therefore? "And Yeshua said unto them, verily, I say unto you, that ye which have followed me in the regeneration, when the Son of man shall sit on the throne in his glory, ye shall also sit upon twelve thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel." "And everyone that had forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife," tell me which one is not important.

Let me start again, "houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, to follow me." Ah, Yeshua, you are the one who provided all of this, and now you are making a list. What is more important than these? Houses, brethren, destiny helpers inclusive, sisters, father, mother, wife, children, lands—what else is left? He says, "He who forsakes for my namesake, shall receive a hundredfold and shall inherit everlasting life."

Chapter Three

Seek Ye First The Kingdom

And Enoch walked with God. What does it take, and what does it mean to walk with Yahweh? To walk with Yahweh means that He becomes the absolute priority in your life and of your destiny; The Bible says, "To seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and every other thing shall be added unto you." Number two, to walk with Yahweh means to love him and to walk in total surrender; to walk with Yahweh involves loving him and walking in complete surrender.

Matthew 22:35, Jesus is teaching us that to walk with Yahweh entails loving him and walking in complete surrender. "Then one of them which was a lawyer asked him a question, tempting him, and saying, Master which is the greatest commandment in the law? Jesus said unto him, thou shall love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul and with all thy mind." Meaning with everything you possess. Next verse, he says, "This is the first and great commandment."

And the second is like unto it, thou shall love thy neighbour as thyself." In verse 40, he says, "On these two Commandments", which suggests that all of the laws that were given were merely to achieve this.

The Love Walk

To bring you to a point of knowledge, imagine that every law given to the nation of Israel, whether the Ten Commandments or the laws that followed that govern their lives, were all natural ways of constraining them to a point where they would love the Lord with all their hearts, souls, and strength. According to these two Commandments, you are only qualified to abolish every other law if you are willing to love the Lord with all your heart, soul, and strength. All laws and prophets hang on these two Commandments.

Mark 3:13-15, the Bible says, "And he goeth up into a mountain and call it unto him whom he would: and they came unto him." This is Yeshua inviting men to walk with him the Bible says, "And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach." And to have power to heal sickness." And where did the "power to heal sickness" come from? From the walking with him, "And to cast out devils." He meant for them to walk with him, when Yahweh calls you, He says follow me not follow it. Anything that reflects your pursuit of Yahweh outside of Him be it business, ministry, prosperity, or fame is idolatry.

Do you realise you can love Heaven more than Yahweh? It is still idolatry because Heaven is not what we worship; it is Him that sits on the throne. What makes heaven, heaven, is not the place, what makes heaven, heaven, is the presence of Yeshua.

Love Above Everything Else

You need to understand this. This text carries a lot of weight: if you want to walk with Yahweh, you must truly love him more than you love your ministry or other interests. He called them and asked them to walk with him, now let us go to Acts 4:13 and see what happened there this was after healing the man at the gate beautiful. "Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled, and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus."

Not that they were powerful anointed men of Yahweh, not that they were great giants and champions, but they had been with Yeshua.

Chapter Four

What is Your Priority?

And Enoch walked with Yahweh, do you know that the Bible tells us little about his family, his ministry, or anything else? We might presume that he walked with Yahweh because nothing else mattered in his life. So, the Bible takes time to tell us that he had a grandfather, a father, a wife, children, and even a ministry. However, none of them came close to him, his testimony had nothing to do with any of them. Enoch walked with Yahweh despite his genealogy, and ability to prophesy correctly.

If you desire Enoch's testimony, your desire to walk with Yahweh does not imply that you neglect anything He has given you. But you exalt him to the degree and position where nothing can replace him. We live in a world today, and while this has been my call for many years, it is still my call to the body of Christ. Please listen to my message. "What seeketh thou." We must return to a point where we no longer use Yahweh, religiosity, and spirituality to achieve our goals. Yahweh is inviting us into a deeper relationship that is greater than a breakthrough, greater than money, and greater than impartation. Yahweh is inviting us to himself, not to eat, but to sell everything that originated from your brain, via your ability to provide value.

The Four Measurements Of Love

Yeshua did not mean that the young man should sell all his possessions; selling something means relinquishing ownership. When you sell something, you part with it. He is saying that when I look at you, I see that you desire me, but the reason you have not been able to focus on perfection is that there are so many other things competing with me. When I speak with Believers, do not tell me how much you love the Lord; love has various levels. We know biology teaches us this, and psychology informs us that love is not generic.

According to Scripture, there are four indices by which we can measure love. Number one is passion; number two is pleasure, number three is commitment, and number four is sacrifice. Your love is not complete unless it contains these four components. Genuine love requires passion, dedication, joy, and sacrifice. The highest biblical metric for measuring love is sacrifice. When you say, "Lord, I love you," He responds, "Show me what you have laid down for me as proof that you love me." When the Bible says Enoch walked with Yahweh, it indicates he exalted Yahweh over his wife, children, and prophetic ministry.

Above all, that indicated relevancy to him. This is what Yeshua was telling the rich young man. He said, "Listen, you want to follow me prove to me that you love me and that I mean more to you than all of your possessions."

Sacrifice The Ultimate Price

And Peter declared, "We have left everything Yeshua I was a fisherman; you saw that I left everything to follow you." He responds," Do not feel bad" because I can guarantee you that when you genuinely abandon everything, you will feel like a fool. If you have not felt foolish and at a loss when following Yahweh, you have not arrived; sacrifice is costly. We have given up everything to follow you, and as a result, we have no idea what our life would entail without you.

You have not given us any information; we are merely following you I am an adult. Married with three children, Peter must be wondering what this one is that we follow you every day. To where will we go? And he says, "I am more important to you than the assignment itself." How many people are more passionate about their work than Yeshua? How many individuals enjoy conferences and conventions more than Yeshua? How many believers love the pulpit, preaching, ministry, healing, and anointing power so much that they would give up Yeshua a thousand times to have it? And Enoch walked with Yahweh.

I hope you understand that you can work for Yahweh while not walking with Yahweh. There is a parable about a man who called people to his vineyard to work, and many of them agreed to go because of the negotiation. They negotiated for a denarius, so they did not travel to the vineyard because they loved him, but because they had a contract. There are many contract believers who say, "Lord, I love you, but I am giving you two months. I will be a worker, but if my breakthrough does not happen, whatever you see, take it that way.

Chapter Five

Total Surrender

What does it mean and what does it take to walk with Yahweh? Complete submission is required when walking with Yahweh. "Father if it is possible take this cup of me" he said, "Nevertheless not my will but yours be done." We need to reach a point in our lives where Yahweh's will and desire outweigh our aspirations, desires, and the things that drive our lives. There are levels of intimacy we can never get into. I submit to you that when you begin to walk with Yahweh, the first thing He does is bring you to a place and point in your Kingdom experience when He begins to dethrone every Idol, even if that Idol represents something good.

It does not have to be evil; if it is not from Yahweh, it must go; two kings cannot sit on the same throne. Yeshua and your brains; Yeshua and your gifts; Yeshua and your relationships. Yeshua and your anointing, Yeshua and your preaching abilities, Yeshua and your ambition, Yeshua and your family. He is not teaching us to be responsible or irresponsible; rather, He is informing us that, in contrast to Yeshua, He has to be in a class and a place by himself.

The Proof Of Love

In Isaiah 6:1, the Bible says, "In the year that King Uzziah died I Isaiah saw the Lord" You cannot see the Lord until something dies. "In the year that King Uzziah died, I now saw the real King sitting on a throne." In the year that my pride died I saw the Lord, in the year that my lust died I saw the Lord. "In the year that my ambition, my obsession to be great and famous as compared to revealing and glorifying Yeshua died, I saw the Lord. if you desire Enoch's testimony, you must answer the question, "Do I love the Lord?" There are clear indicators that demonstrate if and when you love the Lord.

The Bible does not leave you in the dark; there are evidence that you love the Lord. John 14:21, 23, "He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me, and he that loveth me shall be loved of my father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him." In verse 23, Jesus answered and said unto him, if a man loves me, he will keep my words: and my father will love him, and we will come to him and make our abode with him." 1 John 2:15-17, says, "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world." The term "love" is derived from the Greek word "Eros," which refers to an ungodly affinity, passion, and drive for the things of this world that rises above your pursuit of Yahweh.

To not love the world does not imply that you will not be blessed; He created everything richly for us to enjoy. But He advises, "Do not love the world or the things in it." If a man loves the world, it makes no difference if he is a preacher, a politician, or a businessman. He says the love of the father is not in him.

The Three Temptations

In the next verse, he categorises everything that is in the world into three main categories. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the Lust of the eyes and the pride of life is not in the Father. It is not of the Father but of the world, verse 17, "And the world passeth away and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever." Lord, I love you. Lord, I love you. Love is not a meaningless word. I will have to see, "For God so loved the world" he could have said Lord, I love you even though you are suffering, But when he loved the world, he gave and what he gave was his all.

Can you give your only, not your many? You love Yahweh when you reach the place where you can give Him your only. Your only, what does it mean and what does it take to walk with God in total surrender? When he says go left you go left. Go becomes where you go whether it is comfortable or uncomfortable because where he leads you, you are willing to go. If you do not grow to this level, you will never attain maturity in the spirit there is such an obsession for believing in convenience. If your love for Yahweh does not supersede the obsession for pleasure, and the obsession for convenience you cannot be mighty with Yahweh.

We live in a world where our obsession for convenience is greater than our love and our pursuit of Yahweh.

No Pain No Gain

You can witness a woman crying when she goes into labour not just in the delivery room, but during the whole pregnancy. It is within our power to become exhausted one day and say, "Listen, I have made my contribution to this baby, and I am tired," but she does so because she loves the infant more than her condition. You should see how a typical woman's entire life transforms throughout pregnancy. "Well, I would like to have something different to eat. Please bring this," they say. And then they change their mind.

Despite how terrible it is, what she is carrying is worth everything even though she desires something else. Despite how difficult it is, the pregnancy is worthwhile for what she is carrying through all of that. A common complaint among Believers is that their love for Yeshua is insufficient to sustain them through rain, storms, or any other circumstance.

When a man battles through life and comes home with something, even if he does so with scars, he is content that his family can eat, and the sheer satisfaction of knowing that he can provide for his loved ones will outweigh all of his humiliations and sufferings combined. His presence alone turns the race into a gold mine. Do people notice you when you arrive?

Chapter Six

The Three Temptations Explained

For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father but is of the world. 1 John 2:16

In this passage, "lust" refers to the following: a longing desire; an urge to obtain or enjoy; an illicit desire for sexual pleasure; an evil disposition; and corrupted affections and desires. Satan's preferred weapon for leading people astray is to use these three temptations: pride of life, lust of the flesh, and lust of the eyes. These are his primary weapons. According to Genesis 3:6, it was first used successfully against Eve in the Garden of Eden. Eve succumbed to the serpent's three distinct forms of temptations.

"So, when the woman saw that the tree was good for food *[lust of the flesh]* and that it was a delight to the eyes *[lust of the eyes]*, and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise *[pride of life]*, she took of its fruit and ate...

Likewise, the devil employed the same types of temptation against Yeshua Hamashiach: the lust of flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life. The first temptation Yeshua encountered was the lust of the flesh. The devil said to Him, "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." Luke 4:3; As a result, the devil encouraged Yeshua to break his fast in order to satisfy his body. Yeshua's second temptation was the lust of the eyes.

And the devil took Him up and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time, and said to Him, "To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will. If You, then, will worship me, it will all be Yours." Luke 4:5-7. During this temptation, the devil presented Yeshua with the "kingdoms of the world" in an attempt to entice him to worship him in exchange for the material kingdoms he had paraded before him. Yeshua encountered the pride of life as his third temptation.

"And he took him to Jerusalem and set Him on the pinnacle of the temple and said to Him, "If you are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here, for it is written, "He will command His angels concerning you, to guard you," and "On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone." Luke 4:9-11. The devil planned for Yeshua to be tempted in order to determine if Yahweh would submit to a person's will or motives rather than subjecting humanity to Yahweh.

The Lust Of The Flesh

Any immorality or temptation that feeds our physical and carnal appetites is referred to as the lust of the flesh. Anything that satisfies our emotional and physical needs through sin, whether it be

through offering wicked pleasure or otherwise. Fornication, adultery, rape, homosexuality, and other sexual transgressions are examples of the lust of the flesh.

Additional manifestations of the lust of the flesh include consumerism, idolatry, drug and alcohol abuse, gluttony, physical aggression, and so forth. Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians 5:19-21.

The Lust Of The Eyes

The lust of the eyes is to look at things we should not. The lust of the eyes is the desire to stare at something you should not be looking at; it is visualising and imagining of things Yahweh has forbidden us from thinking about. For instance, Yeshua teaches that adultery is not limited to acts involving physical sex. Instead, adultery begins in the mind with looking or imagining.

In Matthew 5:27-28 Yeshua says: "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart."

The lust of the eyes also includes seeing and desiring something that does not belong to you but rather to someone else. Pornography, coveting other people's goods, sensual and adulterous thoughts, and visualising and desiring forbidden things are all examples of eye lust.

The Pride Of Life

A life filled with pride is characterised by the temptation and the need for fame, authority, and recognition. Convictions that one is better or superior to others because of one's education, social status, or other similar characteristics are also considered to be aspects of pride of life.

Empathy can result in conceit, narcissism, hubris, and other types of superiority complexes and self-exaltation. Another temptation brought on by life's pride is the need to win other people's approval and respect by any means necessary. Humility in life and attitude is the opposite of and opposition to life's arrogance.

Summary

One's love for the world is connected to their lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and pride of life. As a result, if we establish a culture of loving and submitting to these three types of temptations, we risk becoming worldly lovers rather than Yahweh's lovers.

In context, the Scripture says: "Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever." 1 John 2:15-17

To avoid worldly temptation, we must follow Yeshua's example and be spiritually grounded in learning and understanding of His word in every situation we face in life. When Yeshua Hamashiach was tempted by the devil, he always responded with Scripture.

Chapter Seven

No More Excuses

Every time Yeshua becomes luggage and a load, check what else has taken his place. When the pursuit of the faith life becomes an inconvenience; going to Yahweh's house, loving Yeshua, prayer, and fasting, the word of God, and corporate fellowship; the instant it becomes a hardship, I want you to check that something is amiss. Because the appearance of excuses always indicates the absence of desire. The rapid appearance of excuses is a telltale sign of lack of passion; when there is no drive or passion, excuses start to appear. "I am busy," you will make excuses; do not forget what I am saying; you may test the absence of passion by the quick appearance of excuses.

There is something wrong with your love life. I am busy, I recently got a promotion, and I have to get back to work. So, you cannot fast, pray, study Yahweh's word, or spend time with Him. The Bible took the time to describe Enoch's family life and other activities. Hence, there is no justification because the Bible never says that he was a false prophet or that he was an irresponsible spouse or father. You have some knowledge of prophecy, and you are aware that it requires a great deal of trust in Yahweh to talk about the return of Yeshua with that degree of accuracy. What depths and heights did he reach during the early days of the dispensation? The Bible claims that Enoch continued to walk with Yahweh in spite of his earthly obligations.

Life Obligations

It follows that having a career, being married, having children, and expanding your ministry are all unacceptable excuses. Tell those excuses today and say, "Lord, I am returning to the altar." All of my weak excuses may seem acceptable at the time, but Enoch cancels them all. If you cite family life as an excuse, Enoch was a family man; but, if ministry is used as an excuse, Enoch was a powerful prophet. If you claim old age as an excuse, Enoch was quite old, but he walked with Yahweh.

If you claim that the reason, I am unable to walk with Yahweh is because I am constantly providing for my children, then what better legacy could there be than having children and then producing one son, Methuselah, who lived the longest of any man on Earth? Proclaim to yourself that you have no justification. For, you make time for the things you enjoy. As much as individuals claim to be busy, if you hear that they are giving away ten thousand pounds in Oxford Street, Central London tonight and will finish at six o'clock tomorrow morning, with passion, determination, and zest, you will find a way to contact a destiny helper.

Even if the other person claims, "I'm going to charge you a thousand pounds. You say that is fine, let's go." I am willing to give you it if I return with nine thousand pounds, I am still in profit. For

where your treasure is your heart is also. Beloved, do not laugh; your heart will always be where your treasure is. If your career or ministry is your treasure, your heart will be there also.

Better Than Earthly Riches

"Abraham, take now your son, your only child, whom you love, and offer him to me on the mount I will show you." Abraham could have instructed one of the servants to kill Isaac on his behalf and then informed Yahweh that Isaac was dead, as the Bible states, "Abraham arose early in the morning and carried Isaac to go and kill him." Genesis 22:2-3. But to kill him by yourself is not easy. My call from Enoch's life is for anyone who has gone astray to return to a position of intimacy with the Lord.

You are the one we praise and honour, and you provide the healing and grace that our hearts long for. And Enoch walked with God. There are many men today who were highly spiritual before marrying and having children, but when they encounter spiritual people or spiritual platforms, they flee because it reminds them of their past. There are students on campus who were undoubtedly on fire years ago because they loved the Lord and decided to use their wisdom and age to graduate from the school of the spirit.

Many people love Yahweh because they have responsibilities in church. If you are a deacon or a pastor, you must be present for the morning prayer. If those titles are removed, the fire follows.

How many homes today do not pray. How many households today do not fast? How many houses today lack a spiritual growth system? The man is up hunting for money, while the woman is up lugging stories from one location to another. Everyone is running from pillar to post, and the youngsters are becoming problematic in the house. Please listen to me. Walking with Yahweh is better than walking with the government. Walking with Yahweh is better than walking with Microsoft or Apple. Walking with Yahweh is superior to walking with any institution on Earth.

May Yahweh grant you the grace to walk with all those wonderful institutions; May Yahweh offer you grace to walk with all of those great organisations; additionally, you must come to the point where you agree that walking with Yahweh is better than walking anywhere else.

Chapter Eight

In His Presence

The average believer has not developed intimacy with the Holy Spirit. It is the reason why, today, our pain and everything that bothers us goes on social media, while our pain and everything that bothers us go on to those around us. Because we have no idea how to find consolation in His presence, those who have walked with Him understand the importance of His presence. His presence is where we come to cry. When Yeshua was preparing to die on the Cross, he was aware of the load that lay on Him. He walked to the place of prayer and said, "Father, there is a place where we can cry, and there is a place where you can empty yourself."

Most of where we are going are in the wrong places; His presence is where you can open up your heart and cry out to the King of kings and Lord of lords. Some individuals, what Yahweh should be doing for you, you are hoping your friends will do it for you. What Yahweh should be doing for you, you hope social media will accomplish and garner sympathy from the entire world. What Yahweh should be doing for you is what you believe money can do for you. Listen, even the greatest of things will fail you; return to his presence, which is where you can cry and know you are secure. That is where you may roll before him. Let me show you a lover's declaration: "Oh God, thou art my God," Psalm 63:1-3, "Oh God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longs for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where there is no water; "to see thy power and thy glory as I have seen in the sanctuary." "Because your loving kindness is better than life."

Can I tell you something? Many of us know who our God is based on how frequently we seek it. So, the uncle you are always disturbing for your lifting, pay close attention; you know who and what your God is based on the frequency with which you visit; every five minutes, you are on social media looking for who will. When Yeshua cries, "Come unto me, all ye who are heavy laden," you run from pillar to post before you get back to Him.

Love Conquers All

To love him above anything else. "What shall separate us from the love of God?" he asks, and he starts enumerating various things. "In all these things we are more than conquerors," He declares. The Bible goes on to say, "For no eye has seen no ear has heard neither has it entered the heart of any man what God has in store." Not for preachers, not for eloquent people, not for fasting giants, not for prayer warriors, not for businesses, but for those who love him. For the people that love him, the people who adore him.

Please hear me, as Yahweh is calling you and saying, "I am still waiting where you left me five years ago." I am still waiting, man of God; I am still waiting for where I was with you before the invitations started to come. I am still there, patiently waiting for you to come back to me. You wept

uncontrollably when you were unemployed, and I am still waiting, where you received your employment letter. Please consider this as Yahweh's voice, for unless we pray for our generation, this degree of lukewarmness will persist. Giving flimsy reasons, it is not about fanaticism, but about passion and desire.

"Simon Barjona, loveth thou me more than this? Loveth thou me more than fame? Loveth thou me more than ministerial exploits? Loveth thou me more than ministry titles? Loveth thou me more than money? If you fail in everything else in life but love Yeshua, you have not failed. If you succeed in all things in life but fail in your love life with Yeshua, you have failed.

Why do most of the young people of today not love Yahweh? Because they observe their parents' level of passion. If they see a father and mother and leaders who are not serious about Yahweh making flimsy excuses, that will become their template as well. When a youngster sees his father rolling before Yahweh every day, saying, "Lord, there is nothing I have and nothing I am except you," that child will eventually come and roll with you, even if he is unaware of what you are doing. We may not grasp what you are doing now for the next 10 to 15 years, but there will be a generation that will not worship Yahweh. May Yahweh forbid it and may shrines return to homes in our lifetime.

Repent (Turn Back)

Not just homes or communities, let me tell you something for some individuals you need to return to the altar and suspend your ministerial activities. You may become spiritually deceived by these invites and open doors, thinking things like, "Oh, I am travelling from country to country, ministering, and doing exploits." Isaiah was ministering while there was a call-in heaven for someone to go out, whereas there was a variety of ministries going on Earth. He can honour you to bless the nations right from the place of His presence, but Satan will give you ministry and open doors a thousand times if it means forfeiting Yahweh's presence.

Yes, Yeshua will open doors for you with his joy, but not all doors that are opened are anointed. There are some doors you must consciously close. Yahweh is saying, "I am still waiting; return to the altar, fire, power, and his presence." He promised them that they would accompany him and thereafter represent him. I would rather be branded a failure as a man of God and still succeed and win with Yahweh than receive the praises of men from all over the world and then have no intimacy with Yahweh.

Chapter Nine

Be A Witness

Question two is the second question we must ask and answer. What does it mean and what does it take to please God? Remember the first question: What does it mean and what does it take to walk with God? We defined it as loving him and prioritising him over everything else in the world, including your own life. It signifies reaching a point and state of complete surrender. We are now attempting to address the second question: what does it mean and what does it take to please God? Let me explain in John 1:6-7 what it means to please God.

"There was a man named John who was sent by God. "Who sent him?" What becomes my joy if I send you to go and do something for me? Is it not in you carrying out my instructions and complete them? And you coming back to me and say, "Sir, I've completed this," The Bible states in the parable of the talents found in Matthew 25: And, unto one he gave five talents, to another two; and to another one;" When he departed; the person with five went about his business and increased it to ten. The one with two to four, and upon his return, he expressed his delight with the phrase "well done, good and faithful servant." Is it true for the last one, who did nothing except complain and even bury his talent? He says, "I know you are a hard man who likes to reap what you did not sow, so instead of wasting this, I will bury it." Here is your talent," he said, calling him a wicked and unprofitable servant.

Corporate Mandate

What does it take and what does it mean to please God? John 1:6-7 says, "there was a man sent from God", that man was you. "The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the light, that all men through him might believe." This is every believer's corporate assignment, whether you are a businessman, a man of God on the pulpit, a politician, a captain of industry, or anything else; spiritual progress is our corporate purpose in this Kingdom. As you get to know Yahweh and desire to understand his ways, you will eventually come to realise that our corporate responsibility is to bear witness.

A witness is the validator of Yahweh's claim, and there is no better way to bring Yahweh joy than to bear witness to the light. It declares that by means of that witness, all men may be saved. In John 4:34, "Yeshua said unto them my meat," which means "my satisfaction is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work." When you read Enoch's prophecy in Jude 1:14, you will see that he was inviting his people to return to the realm of righteousness, to the point where they would acknowledge the God of Heaven.

He called them and warned them, "Beware, he is coming with the cloud, to judge this and that, and to call them back. This was what John did. For a long time, John was the voice crying out in

the desert, urging people to turn from their sins. John was the voice pleading with the people to turn from their sins in the desert. And he did it well for a long time, until bitterness and offence overcame him, and he veered off into something else. He paid the price by dying cheaply.

Soul Winner

Daniel 12:3, "And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament: and they that turned many to righteousness as stars forever and ever." They that turn many, not you, to righteousness, I can tell you what it takes to please Yahweh beyond studying your Bible and teaching. When you actively participate in being a witness and utilise everything Yahweh has given you. You use all that Yahweh has given you be it talent, beauty, anointing, or anything else to glorify him and raise the banner of righteousness and light throughout the world, contributing to the establishment of the Kingdom.

That is a life that pleases Yahweh, as Enoch testified. The testimony of Enoch was not the accuracy of his prophecy. Unfortunately, these are the credentials we employ today as men of God and as businesspeople. I am a fantastic Pastor, an accurate Prophet, and a superb Apostle. Those things are fantastic, but if you convert Enoch's testimony, it is not the life of a preacher, nor is it the accuracy of a prophet. The testimony of Enoch is not a man who knows economic systems in order to accumulate so much wealth; rather, the testimony of Enoch is a life in which you use the time you have and all of your resources to become the light. As you truly become light, you become someone who pleases the Father. Yeshua had the same testimony as Enoch: "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Chapter Ten

Purpose

Nothing is valuable and profitable unless it is connected to a purpose. The challenge for the body of Christ is that we teach spiritual principles in isolation of being a witness and the Kingdom Come. Even if it is the truth, teaching it in isolation from and in opposition to Yahweh's agenda is self-destructive. So, if I teach you prosperity and principles, nothing will benefit you unless they are linked to the objective of being a witness and the agenda of kingdom come. Now you can learn about power since it is tied to your witness, and now you can learn about prosperity without feeling guilty about it.

You can be reading a book on success and declare I am a kingdom millionaire; this is not the result of a carnal man's lusty communication. But one who is aware of the part money will play in both realising the Kingdom Come agenda and helping you become an effective witness. I can summarise the Believers walk in a few sentences. The whole faith life is not complicated. Step one is Yeshua and all about Him; the true path for the believer begins with an encounter with Yeshua. And that comes from hearing the Gospel's saving message. Then, at the point of redemption, you are introduced to the Holy Spirit's personality as well as the word of God.

The moment you have an encounter with the Holy Spirit and the revelation of Yahweh, your journey into the kingdom experience officially begins. Then you are given the privilege of being connected to human vessels who will now work in collaboration with the word and the Spirit to begin that job of systematic mentorship and growth in your life.

Witnessing - The Kingdom Concept

Once you reach a certain level of understanding, which requires thorough mentoring to teach you the principles of the Kingdom, line by line and precept by precept, you have reached a significant level of maturity. Now that you know who you are and what your rights are, we introduce the kingdom concept to remind you that Yahweh has a responsibility over you. All of the benefits of a long life are designed to enable you to be an effective witness.

Only when you realise your role as a witness and the purpose for everything Yahweh gives you. Now your prayer and desires will make sense, for in the name of Yeshua, I will never be poor. I agree with you, but for what purpose? I come from a poor family. I have suffered. Before I pass away, I want to enjoy a happy life. That is not a wise man's approach. I desire this wealth because, according to the blueprint of the instructions entrusted to me, Kingdom funding plays a significant role in Kingdom Come. And because Yahweh has joyfully summoned you to fulfil that role, he will provide you with resources that you can never have imagined. since it is associated with a purpose. As believers, we must repent and moderate our blind zeal for things unrelated to Yahweh; since they will inevitably bring us to ruin.

Thy Kingdom Come

The prayer that comes before "Give us this day our daily bread" is "Thy kingdom come, and thy will be done." He makes two statements about the kingdom: "Give us our daily bread," and "Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who trespass against us." Everything was related to our being witnesses because he says, "lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil" for the sake of the kingdom. And according to Enoch's account, he pleased Yahweh. But how did he do that? By being a light for his generation, a beacon that draws men to righteousness.

You must spend your life actively contributing with your life and resources, whether as a preacher or in whatever area your witness is located. You must endeavour to see Yeshua glorified and revealed; otherwise, you may be a believer but not please the Lord. How about the offering I made the other day? Before your offer is accepted, we must determine what motivated it. If it is only a transaction because you were told that money would come back Yahweh may still be compassionate to you mercifully.

You are doing your best with what you know, but being a witness does not call for you to stand behind the pulpit. I truly do not want to be recognised solely for being a brilliant teacher and kingdom worker, thank God; for if there is one testimony I crave in my life, it is this one: Enoch's testimony. He testified that he pleased Yahweh, saying, "If all you have is Yeshua, you have more than gold, and I will tell it to the world.

Chapter Eleven Good Works

Yeshua says in First Corinthians 3:13 that our works will be tested.

Our work does not save us. However, after we are saved, we do good work. The Bible says, "By grace, have you been saved through faith and not of yourself? It is the gift of God, not a result of his works, unless anyone should boast. Then he says, For we are his workmanship created in Christ Jesus, who created us for good works. When you are reborn, you are made in Yeshua Hamashiach to do good. The sole reason to be on Earth is to do good and lead men and women to salvation. You could die and go to heaven after being born again, but Yahweh calls you to a life on Earth to be a blessing, you are blessed to be a blessing.

Our work will be tested by fire. It does not imply that you will experience fire. It states that if your works after salvation are only transient wood, hay, and stubble, they will be burned. However, if your works are gold, silver, and precious stones, if they exalt Yahweh, bring others to him, and introduce people to the true Yeshua, they will pass through the fire. And the gold, silver, and precious stones of what you have used your life for; if you have used your life for Yahweh's glory, when you get to heaven, you will realise that your works persevered and survived. And if you brought one soul into the kingdom and led them to a closer walk with Yahweh, those are the works He is looking forward to.

Benefits Of Walking With Yahweh

When you walk with Yahweh, he will prepare you for what is to come. This is vital, and you should understand that. Enoch lived a prophetic life, and Yahweh inspired him to name his son Methuselah. The name Methuselah means "when he dies, it will be sent". Methuselah lived 969 years, but when he died, Yahweh sent the flood. Yahweh told Enoch what to name his son since Enoch was walking with God. Yahweh revealed to him what was to come, including the fact that following Methuselah's death, there would be destruction, and Yahweh would bring the flood, followed by judgement.

Three Things You Need To Walk With God

Walking with God requires three things. Number one is to live a faith-filled life. Hebrews 11:5 reads, "Enoch by faith," watch this now. Enoch was taken from this life so that he did not see death, and he could not be found since the Lord had taken him." And, before he was taken, he had this testimony that he was pleasing to God." What should be our primary incentive in life? To please Yahweh? Because when we are pleasing to Yahweh, it is making us ready for him to take us away.

We should not prepare to be taken away; instead, we should learn how to please Yahweh. The very next line gives us instructions on how to please Him: "But without faith it is impossible to please God." So, walking with Yahweh is a life of faith; what you believe impacts your words, feelings, and deeds. Faith is a belief in which you are convinced. Many people have faith in the wrong things. They are convinced of something, and whenever you are convinced of something, it starts to manifest in your life. When you believe that Yahweh maintains his promises, they will begin to manifest in your life.

Faith is not hoping or wishing. Faith is the conviction of what Yahweh said or what someone informed you about Yahweh is true; you are simply convinced and certain that what has been said is the truth.

Life Of faith

I promise you that not everything people say is true, but we can be certain that whatever Yahweh says is the truth. I am convinced that we shall have better days, and that Yahweh will show up in our lives. I am convinced that something good will happen and that I will witness Yahweh's goodness in the land of the living. I am convinced that a miracle is going to happen in my life today; I am convinced that my life and your life will be full of pleasant surprises that Yahweh does just to surprise you.

Just so you can say, "Wow, look what Yahweh did; I had no idea it was coming that way." Or at that time or with that amount but look at how Yahweh fulfilled his promise. I am confident that he will keep his promise to me, just as he did to Abraham. If he kept his word to David, I have faith he will keep it to me. If he kept his promise to Isaac, I am confident he will keep his pledge to me. Walking with God is a life of faith in which we believe despite the fact that we cannot see it; being convinced of something does not require seeing it.

How do you walk with God? Walking with God is a journey of faith. Paul went on to say, "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race; I have kept the faith." Just keep believing and stop worrying about seeing it and be convinced of its coming. We are not convinced by what we see; rather, we are convinced by what we believe and by the track record of the One who promised it. Walking with Yahweh is a life of faith.

Life Of Fellowship

Walking with God is a Life of Fellowship. In 2 Timothy 1:12b, the apostle Paul says something amazing: "I know whom I have believed," yet he does not say, "I know about him in whom I believe." So, I do not just believe in him or about him; I do not simply know him because someone else says I do. I know who I know; he says I know him; I believe, and I am convinced that he is capable of carrying out what I committed to him that day. He said, "I believe, and I am convinced." Why? Because he is familiar with him.

When you know someone, you become convinced, believe, and are persuaded by their track record. When you know someone is always late, you are convinced they will be late this time as well. When you know they keep their promises, you are convinced they will keep their promise this time, too. The more consistent they are, the more you can rely on them, and we need to know that Yahweh has always been reliable in our lives, families, and throughout history. He has never broken any of His promises, therefore we can have fellowship with him, whom we know. We are

not fellowshipping with a concept of Yahweh; we are fellowshipping with Yahweh; it is all about knowing Yahweh.

Walking with Yahweh is a life of fellowship that begins with faith and ends with fellowship. Micah 6:8 says at the end of the verse, "showing you a man what is good what does the Lord require of you." I like the phrase "to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God." How can one walk humbly? Walk humbly with your God, not beneath your God, not towards your God, and not for your God. Walk humbly with your God, but with my God; he cannot be the God of another person. I am not trusting the pastor's God; you must make Him yours.

Remember that it is not life under Yahweh, life over Yahweh, life from Yahweh, or life for Yahweh, but life with Yahweh.

Life Of Fruitfulness

Walking with Yahweh is a life of fruitfulness. A life of faith is the first requirement for walking with God. Number two, walking with God is a life of fellowship, and number three, it is a life of fruitfulness. In John 15:7-8, Jesus says, "Abide in me, and let my words abide in you, you will ask whatever you desire, and it shall be done for you." That statement should transform your life: "By this is my Father glorified that you bear much fruit; and show yourselves as my disciples."

The only way to bear fruit is to sow seeds, and the only way to be productive is to plant and nurture seeds. You know that kindness towards others, being in the right environment, and persevering through harvests and fruitfulness are what nourish those seeds. Walking with Yahweh will produce fruit, and that fruit is going to endure because it is for his glory and for your good.

Please return; he is still waiting; you see, the lovely thing about Yeshua is that His arms are wide open to welcome you back. The prodigal son said, "How many hired servants does my father have, and I am here feeding the swine? I will arise and go to my father, and I will say, "Father, I have sinned against you and against Heaven, I am not fit to be called your son; take me as one of your servants." According to the Bible, as he got up and moved, he saw his father, who came and hugged him, kissed him, put that royal garment on him, and restored the signet ring. Luke 15:15-22.

This is not about fanaticism, nor is it about foolish pursuits that cause imbalance and destroy every aspect of your life; rather, it is about rearranging your life in such a way that you succeed holistically. There is nothing wrong with seeking testimonials similar to those of celebrities if that is what you want in your life. Noble testimonial from an entrepreneur who began with nothing and rose to prominence in his community. The wonderful testimony of a responsible and outstanding father; the testimony of a hardworking individual who overcame all obstacles to become famous; a wonderful witness.

The testimony of one who battled his way out of idolatry to come into relationship with Yeshua. But the best testimony that anyone can have is Enoch's. And Enoch, the seventh man from Adam, walked with God and testified (Hebrews 11:5) that he pleased God. As busy as we may be, if all we do does not, please Yahweh, I promise you that we are wasting our time and the gift of time that Yahweh has given us. It all comes down to being a testimony for the Kingdom.


If you are not walking with God before having children, you will realise how important it is to walk with God after having children. We need his help.






