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Introduction

The power of belief is the most powerful force a person can possess. I used to believe that the most powerful force anyone could have, is the power of God (Holy Spirit). But this is not the case. Unbelief is so powerful that it can prevent Yahweh's power from manifesting in your life.

Yahweh, in the Bible, tells the children of Israel, "You have hindered Me with your unbelief." Psalm 78:17-19 NIV. When Yeshua came to a certain town thousands of years later, He was unable to heal or perform any miracles due to their unbelief. Matthew 13:58 NIV.

Unbelief has the power to stop the flow of Yahweh's power in a person's life. As a result, belief and unbelief have the same power. What you do not believe has the same power as what you do believe. As a result, unbelief is belief in the inverse (negative) sense. They are the opposite sides of the same coin.

What Exactly Is Belief?

Belief is a strong conviction and perception of reality. Belief is what one believes to be true. As a result, belief has something to do with conviction; Belief has something to do with perception and truth. The concept of belief can be expressed in a variety of ways, using words such as,

- Trust,
- Hope,
- And mind-set,

Have you heard of the word mindset? It has something to do with faith. When you say I do not like your way of thinking, you mean I am not too fond of how you perceive reality. Belief can also be interpreted as,

- Persuasion,
- I am persuaded, which means I am convinced of certain things.

There is also an expression in the word "conviction", which is "it is my conviction about", Life, Money, People, Marriage, and Children. The belief system of man originates and resides in the soul of man.

The Soul Of Man

The intellect is the centre of the soul; what is the soul? The combination of your mind, will, and emotions—or, to put it another way, the three components that make up the soul. So, your feelings reside within your soul. Your soul is where you store your thoughts and where you make decisions. Making your soul the most crucial part of your life. Permit me to explain why the Bible said, "And he that wins souls is wise," and why the struggle of life is for a person's soul.

Now, why did Yeshua make that statement? You see, getting a body is easy, and obtaining a spirit is even easier; you may be reborn in seconds, but winning your soul is difficult. My mission as a teacher and communicator is to work on your soul. I am after your soul: And I hope to win it. I have already won your body because you are reading this book.

I want your spirit because you want to know Yahweh; nevertheless, winning your soul is a more difficult undertaking because it takes longer than winning your body and spirit. You are born again in a second, but converting you is a difficult task; therefore, the battle is for your soul, the soul of the people, the soul of the nation, the soul of your children, and the soul of your spouse. I want you to understand that your soul is under attack and that you are in danger.

What makes the soul the first component in Yahweh's medium? Because the soul serves as a mediator between the spirit and the body, it is a medium.

Rulership

The essence of Yahweh's original purpose is that whoever controls the soul controls the man. As a result, the unseen man must rule the seen world from the unseen realm while inhabiting the seen body. Stated differently, Yahweh intends to rule the world through you. He intended to do so from the unseen realm through your invisible Spirit residing within your body, and he intended to accomplish this on Earth. So that his invisible intent could be visible through your acts and your deeds.

Yahweh therefore intended to rule the world through you and your spirit, rather than by us. It is important to understand that the soul serves as Yahweh's medium for Kingdom rule. This is why the Bible says, "I wish above all things that you prosper," but notice the focus "even while your soul prospers." Therefore, you are seriously ruining your life if you do not receive the correct information. Yahweh's kingdom is the kingdom of the soul, also known as the Kingdom of the Heart.

If the kingdom of God cannot enter your soul, it cannot reach the Earth, and if it cannot enter your heart, the Earth will never know Yahweh's rulership. Rulership originates in the heart, and until it does, no Kingdom manifestation will occur on Earth.

Chapter One

The Mind

The brain is the most powerful organ in your body, with over five hundred billion cells, according to experts. The brain is so powerful that it can store things that happened to you as a baby in its membrane. Even if you are sixty years old, your brain can remember events from when you were six years old. The brain is amazing; it can calculate a million times faster than a computer, but most of us do not use our brains in this way.

However, there is a force greater than the brain, and that force is the mind. Why? Because the mind is comprised of the faculties of thought and reasoning. The mind has two dimensions, meaning that you have two minds. Your first mind is the dimension known as "the heart" Your second mind is known as "the mind" They both exist in your thinking and thought faculties.

The mind is first and foremost the faculty of consciousness, the element of man's thinking that is reflexive and makes him aware of his immediate surroundings. The portion of you that deals with reactions is your mind. The mind is a mechanism that operates in consciousness and is used to make decisions. Your mind is how you respond to the world around you; it is always active, making you aware of how cold or hot it is. The mind is a part of your brain mechanism that allows you to be aware of what is going on right now. The mind must be distinguished from the heart because the mind is constantly active and constant. But the heart is a different story.

The Will Of Man

There is nothing on Earth as powerful as the human will, nothing more powerful than that. The human will is so powerful that Yahweh Himself does not control it. I want you to remember that there is one thing that Yahweh does not control on Earth and that is the human will, why? Because the very nature of a will implies self-control, Yahweh gave you the power of will. Number two, the will controls the destiny of man. Your will is the agency of Yahweh's kingdom Administration.

When Yahweh established His kingdom on Earth, he wanted it to be administrated through the will of man, the problem is your will is yours. The most dangerous gift Yahweh ever gave man is a will and the most precious gift Yahweh ever gave man is a will. It is both dangerous and precious. It is precious because Yahweh gave you the same power that he possesses, the power of will. But it is also dangerous because you can choose to go against Yahweh; that is how dangerous a will is.

Yahweh intended to use the will of man to fulfil His purpose on Earth so Yahweh wanted you to use your will for His purpose the only problem is a will gives you the power to choose even against the will of the one who gave you the will. I want you to follow this way of thinking now.

The Subconscious Mind

The third point is that the conscious and subconscious minds are the places where the will resides. It resides in the heart; your heart is your subconscious mind, which is the seat of control over your life. In case you are unaware, you have two minds: a conscious mind and a subconscious mind. The conscious mind is always present, but the subconscious mind is deeper and more significant than the conscious mind. Your conscious mind provides information to the subconscious mind, and the more information your conscious mind receives, the more it feeds the subconscious mind.

That is why repetition is dangerous. Repetition constantly enters your conscious mind, but the more it hears anything, the more it begins to deposit or, to use a technical term, downloads it into your subconscious mind. You are safe as long as something is in your conscious mind, since you may forget what you are thinking about. The key is not to get it to your subconscious mind; once it gets there, you are in trouble because the mind is the centre of thought, and it holds the key to life.

Now, when I use the word mind, another statement to note is "As a man thinks, so is he," which most people quote but please quote it correctly: "As a man thinks in his heart." There are two types of thinking: thinking and heart thinking. Here, "heart" is a Hebrew term that denotes the lower mind, or subconscious mind. Proverbs 23:7, NIV.

Chapter Two

The Heart

The heart is man's subconscious faculty and the dimension of his thinking where experience is stored. Following that, it keeps any resolutions that you have made.

- To be,
- To do,
- To go.

The heart also stores convictions; it is the location of convictions. Convictions are felt in your heart rather than in your mind.

- The heart is where belief is stored,
- The heart is also where secret hopes are stored,
- The heart is also where our fears are stored,
- Deep fears, the fear of not trying because you might fail.

Your heart is also the home of your desires; it is the source of your deep hunger. So, according to this definition, your heart is not the organ that pumps blood through your body. But the part of your being that connects your spirit to your mind, this is your true heart. The Bible refers to your heart as "the spirit of the mind" in several places. This implies that you have a mind and that your mind has a spirit mind. There is a distinction between the mind gets there, you are in trouble because the mind is the centre of thought, and it holds the key to life.

Your mind has a reflex ability; it happens quickly. Your heart is reflective; it is the part of you that thinks. It is the part of you that considers things. For example, your mind may decide to do something wrong, But your heart has a meeting on it, So, your mind and heart will sometimes contradict each other. Your mind may say, "Let us do this," but your heart may say, "Let us talk about it first." So, your heart is the reflective component, and your mind is the reflexive component.

The Heart Of The Matter

Your heart is where you make decisions, your mind is where you have reflexes, and you cannot trust your mind. Whatever is in your heart will govern your mind's reactions. So, whatever is going

on in your head is not really who you are. You are what is in your heart, and your heart determines exactly what your mind will eventually do.

The heart serves as the basic framework and material for the mind. The heart provides materials for the mind to work with; in essence, the mind reacts to the heart's responses. I want you to know this because it will help you understand doctrine rather than just simply knowing scripture. You need a doctrine because scriptures just lodge in the mind, which is why you can know a lot of scriptures and continue to sin.

The Heart Of Man

According to Solomon, your subconscious mind is your heart, and whoever owns your heart controls your life. Whoever can get enough information into your subconscious mind will have control over you since a man is defined by what he believes in his heart. So, if you want to dominate the man, all you need to do is control his heart. But how do you achieve that? You start with the conscious mind and keep repeating it until it is deposited in the heart, at which point you are in trouble.

That is why some people are having difficulty with disputes over things they want to change but cannot. All the bad habits that you have been keeping for the past twenty years now that you want to change are hard to break.

Young people, that is why Yahweh warns you to avoid evil things; if you continue to view pornography, read immoral literature, or hear nasty stories or dirty jokes, it will get downloaded. What occurs after anything is downloaded to your hard drive is that it continues to execute even when you are not aware of it. And all you have to do is press the right button to see all the photographs in colour. That is why the Bible instructs us to take note of what we hear.

If you fail to control what enters your conscious mind, it will eventually become a part of your subconscious mind and is then in your heart. The Bible says, "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks." The issues of life arise from the heart, according to what Yeshua said: "For evil thoughts—murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander—come from the heart." The mind, which is defined as the heart, dictates a man's future and destiny. What I mean is that you are the sum of the decisions you make.

Whatever you choose to hear, see, and listen to continually will shape your future. The simple fact of life is that you become what you are constantly hearing and seeing.

Habits

Some people are still troubled by habits that they have been attempting to break. I have been born again for twenty years and am still struggling; the solution is that you downloaded some information that is still there. So, how can you clean a hard drive that has been filled with unwanted data? When you are unable to wipe the undesirable data, you occasionally have to get a new hard disc. However, you use a different programme to clean it up, and that is what the Holy Ghost does. It is Yahweh's programme that uses the word of God as its material.

You are expected to hear and hear and hear the word of God at all times. Until it drowns out what was there for 20 years that is the only way to do it There is nothing more to be done until what was there for twenty years gets replaced or wiped out.

Chapter Three

The Soul

Your spirit is not your problem because you are a spirit; rather, your soul is your problem since it determines what your spirit receives. Your body is only a lump of dirt, and the devil is not interested in that. He is not chasing your spirit because it is already occupied with someone, but he can still manipulate a critical component: your soul. Which comprises your mind, will, and emotions, the soul serves as the intermediary between the spirit and the body. The soul receives from the senses and gives information to the spirit, this is very important.

In other words, hearing, tasting, seeing, touching, and feeling all come from the senses, but they all travel to the soul, where they are processed by your mind, will and emotions. Therefore, your soul receives all that you see, touch, taste, feel, or hear. You must now ensure that you are in alignment with the soul that is receiving information from your senses as it takes it and deposits it into your spirit. And that is why Yeshua advised, "Take heed what you hear," which means to selectively manage what you are hearing.

What do you want to listen to and why? He said, "Because it will leaven the whole lump" it will ruin your life. Here is the tricky part: the spirit communicates with the body through the soul, which presents some challenges. Your body gathers data from everything it touches, tastes; sees, smells, and feels and sends it to your soul.

Inner Conflict

Then it enters your spirit, and when the spirit receives information from the soul obtained from the body, it has to deal with it. The issue arises when the spirit communicates with the soul after gaining access to all this information and requests action from the body. So, the spirit directs the soul to inform the body what to do. You have a few issues at this point. Occasionally, the soul conflicts with the body because it refuses to comply with the spirit's wishes. That is what you refer to as a mental battle or spiritual warfare.

So, your spirit says the information I received is wicked, and the soul says, but that is all the body gave me. When the body does not get faith, which comes from hearing, and you hear through your body, the soul believes it and transmits it to the spirit. Your spirit receives and conceives it if it contains the spirit of God; it is not a missing spirit; it is located on the inside of this spirit. If the Holy Spirit disagrees with what the spirit has recently received, what Yahweh's Spirit says now, it is not righteous information.

So, the spirit of the man informs the soul that the information received is not righteous and instructs the body to change the source of the information. The body invites the soul to experience it, saying, "It feels good." The soul responds, "It does feel good." And the spirit replies, "But it is not right," at which point the body responds, "It feels sensually good, don't you like it, soul," and the spirit tells the body to stop. And the soul says, "I know it is wrong, but it feels good emotionally," and the spirit loses, and the spirit now downloads information that is starving it to death.

The Human Trinity

Do you know who the most significant member of the human Trinity is? Since the soul can accept or reject the information, it is the soul. Thus, the body can only do what the soul commands it to do, and the soul can only do what it accesses from the spirit. The soul takes from the body and delivers it to the spirit, but the spirit also takes from the Spirit of God and gives to the soul for the body. For this reason, the Bible instructs us to "walk in the spirit, not in the flesh, and you will not fulfil the lust of the flesh."

It is an enigma that the soul both gives to and receives from the spirit. Not only does the soul feed the spirit, but the spirit also feeds the body via the soul. Furthermore, you must exercise caution in what you see and hear. Avoid letting anything entice your taste buds, as this is what narcotics are known to do. When you use drugs, you taste, feel, and sense something that your soul starts to emotionally like but that your spirit rejects. However, if you do it frequently and it downloads, you will have a problem when you wish to stop using drugs because it becomes lodged in your heart, preventing you from ever cleaning it out.

To become entirely habit-free, you must replace your old habits with new ones that require acquiring new information. The first thing to remember about man is that he is a spirit who inhabits a body and has a soul. And that is the unified trinity of man.

Chapter Four

Difference Between Listening And Hearing

When you receive information, it enters your mind but does not affect you. There is a distinguishable difference between listening and hearing. On numerous occasions, Yeshua said, "Let these words sink into your ears." Luke 9:44. He was speaking to people who had two ears and could hear him. However, He stated that they were not listening to what He was saying. Hearing occurs in the mind, but listening occurs in the heart. Yeshua, I know you can hear me, but you are not paying attention.

What Yeshua is saying is that He has been speaking for some time, and you have been hearing what He has been saying, but you have not been listening, as your behaviour does not match what He has been saying. You can hear without listening, Hearing consumes no energy. Because people hear but do not listen, most relationships will experience difficulties. For many years, I recall being able to recall scriptures, but they had not yet become a revelation to me and hence had not been applied to my life.

The heart, not the mind, is the key to living. It is simply a passing thought till information enters the heart. Until the information reaches the heart, it will not affect the individual's behaviour. For this reason, there is a distinction between hearing and listening: Change does not occur until it reaches your heart; regardless of how you hear information, it will not affect you until it reaches your heart.

Spiritual Warfare

The first word of Yeshua's public ministry Matthew 4:17 says, "And Jesus began to preach repentance," which means to change your mind. Your mind is in your soul, and if I can transform your soul, he continues, the kingdom of heaven will come to Earth. Yahweh and Satan are engaged in spiritual warfare for your soul; the kingdom of darkness is also the kingdom of the soul. In reality, Yahweh and Satan are seeking your soul, not your body, even if the latter is vital to the planet. Because whatever controls your soul has control over you.

I believe we have become so spooked that we have lost track of where the battle is. We get so spiritually paranoid that we start creating imaginary devils. We are fighting things that do not exist, and we are missing the actual battle. Yeshua said, "If you hear my teaching, if you follow and listen to my words, they are spirit and they will give you life", John 6:63. We have two kingdoms, and both are vying for your soul. He is trying to get it through your soul that if He can transform your thinking, you will be sanctified.

Emotions

This is a war for the mind. Your thoughts, desires, and feelings make up your soul. If you think

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about it, this explains why most people are losing these battles. What do you believe is keeping you from leaving a situation you know is wrong? It is your emotions. Satan has got you; one phone call and your knees are weak, and you have returned to that sinful relationship. The battle is finished the moment you feel your knees weakening and begin leaving the house to drive there.

The Holy Spirit is shouting, "Stop, turn around, do not go back there, he does not love you, it will break up your marriage," yet you are still driving. You are hearing but not listening and the conflict never ends.

What Are You Listening To?

What is the media? Since Yahweh's media is the soul, let us talk about the media. The word media comes from the word medium. There is an attack on your soul that you would never imagine. You have hundreds of channels on your broadband with a remote control, and every button is aimed at your soul. So, you better grasp what they are doing. Every station is seeking your soul; this is not entertainment; it is confinement. That is all that matters; it is about the media, and the word media comes from the word medium. They want to control and confine you.

Chapter Five

The Real You

The heart is the centre of behaviour, the foundation of action, and the key to life. What exactly is the heart? It is your subconscious mind that stores beliefs and convictions that govern your behaviour. In a nutshell, the heart is the person, and the person is what is in his heart. This theme can be found throughout the Bible.

The Bible does not say that "as a man thinketh, so is he", as most people think, Proverbs 23:7a. According to the Bible, "Man thinks in his subconscious faculty where convictions are." As a result, you can tell people what is on your mind rather than what you believe. Because what you believe will eventually come out of your mouth, we must be careful about what we believe in our hearts. Just as water reflects a person's face, a man's heart reflects him. This means that, just as you can see yourself when you gaze into a reflecting element, you can see yourself when you look into your heart.

It Stems From The Heart

Your heart manifests itself in your life; You are what is in your heart. As a result, what is in your heart determines your life; And the heart is the part of you with all your convictions, your beliefs, and all the things you hold to be true. This is the real you. Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see Yahweh Matthew 5:8. Yahweh is implying that if your subconscious mind is pure, holy, and free of corruption, you will be able to see Him in everything. It means that if your subconscious is pure and filled with Yahweh's word, you will see Yahweh's work in all you do.

You perceive Yahweh's people differently when you see them, which is why it is difficult for a man to murder another man with a pure heart. Because you cannot kill Yahweh if your heart is pure by murdering a man. Any man who kills another man, according to the Bible, is destroying Yahweh's image. Why does Yahweh say to kill a man who kills another man? It is not a discussion about capital punishment this is not important to Yahweh.

Created In His Image

Yahweh is saying that you do not understand the deeper conviction; if you can kill a man and destroy Yahweh's image, you do not deserve to live because no man can kill Yahweh and live. It is impossible, and it has to do with conviction and doctrine. What are your thoughts on man? If you believe man is created in Yahweh's image, you will respect him, even in the gutter.

- Be careful how you treat the vagabond.
- Be careful how you treat the drug addict.
- They have an issue, not that they are an issue.

You will see them as Yahweh sees them, which is why Yeshua can take a woman who has had five husbands and turn her into an evangelist from out of nothing. Why? He was convinced of the products, which he had created; He knew who they were. His convictions were correct. The pure in heart are blessed, for they will see Yahweh everywhere they look.

What Is In Your Heart

“For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.” Luke 12:34 NIV. To elaborate, the scripture says that whatever you believe in, you will pay for it. You will hold it dearly and you will treasure it if you truly believe in it, and you will devote it as a treasure. As a result, your faith will always have an impact on what you treasure. We uphold Yahweh's work because we believe in everything He is doing. According to Yeshua, “Take heart my son your sins are forgiven” Matthew 9:2 NIV. He says to the woman with the issue of blood “Take heart my daughter your faith has healed you”. Matthew 9:22 NIV.

Now I want you to pay attention to the word “take heart.” Have you ever heard of this phrase? Take heart man, although you have never considered what it means. The term “heart” refers to a human ability that deals with belief and conviction. Yeshua is stating here that if you believe, your faith will make you whole. Your belief is your faith. What you believe in, What you have faith in, What you trust in, And what you act on.

While talking about the heart, Yeshua says in Matthew 12:33-37, “Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.” O, generation of vipers, how can you, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. A good man out of the good treasure of the heart brings forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. But I say unto you, that every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgement. For by your words, you shalt be justified, and by your words, you shalt be condemned.”

The Source Of Life

Please keep in mind that Yeshua stated that the heart is the centre and source of your life and that if you have an evil heart, you cannot do good. And if you have a good heart, it is terrible when you do evil because you feel bad about it and you are not following your heart. This is why the fruit is linked to the root; the root being your heart, and the fruit is your behaviour, words, and actions. This is why doctrine must be linked to behaviour; when you believe something, it must be reflected in the way you live.

Chapter Six

The Conviction Of Love

"...Love the Lord your God with all your heart." Mark 12:30 NIV. This means that Yahweh desires that your entire subconscious life be filled with who He is and the revelation of His word. The first item on the list is to love the Lord with all your heart. Yahweh desires your heart.

Jesus said, "How foolish you are, and how slow your heart is to believe." Luke 24:25 NIV.

Is it possible to have a slow heart? Yes, in other words, it takes a long time for your heart to get something your mind has had for a long time. Your mind can grasp it quickly, but it can take some time to get it into your heart, and the problem is that you cannot be trusted until it reaches your heart. This is why many people believe in giving offerings but do not practice it. Giving an offering is in their minds but not in their hearts; if it is in your heart, you do not need to be told or reminded. It just happens as part of your natural behaviour.

Love In The Heart

Some say I need to learn to love, but I do not! If you have love in your heart, it is difficult to hate anyone or stay out of a relationship for an extended period. This is why the Bible says, "God's love has been shed abroad in our hearts." Romans 5:5, NIV. You do not have to try to love if it is in your heart. Your conviction is love: your preoccupation is love; as a result, when love is in your heart, you cannot discriminate or bring any condition to your relationships. I love everyone because I believe they are deserving of love. Love is supposed to be in the subconscious centre of your entire being.

"Do you not see that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and then out of the body? But the things that come out of a person's mouth come from the heart, and this is what defiles you. For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander. Matt 15:17-19.

Notice how the entire list begins with thoughts; you do not just kill people; you think about it first. Why? It is in your heart,

- It is a subconscious thought.
- A conviction,
- A man burning up his wife tells me more about a doctrinal problem.

A Nuisance

In other words, our society is not absent of doctrine; we have simply been indoctrinated with the wrong information. When you conclude that your children and spouse deserve to die because of

your discomfort, you have effectively reduced human life to a nuisance. What a conviction, now I must be honest, the frequency of the destruction of human lives in our society is far too frequent, far too high, I mean, every day someone is shot, stabbed, or killed, and what is frightening is that we are complicit in it. However, it begins with a heart condition; something is wrong with people's hearts. And the heart is the part of the mind that thinks. where your convictions are stored. They are adamant about everything they believe in.

What Do You Value

Their conviction is that if you get in my way, I will “dis” you, implying that you are nothing more than a nuisance. You are no longer an image of God; you are simply,

- A dog,
- A cat,
- A rat,
- You are an animal,
- You are not truly a spirit in a body created in the image of God.

Because you are not valuable enough for Yeshua to die for you, I murder you. Imagine having this kind of conviction in our country. Adultery is next on the list; if the heart is right, adultery is impossible. Consider people who say, "I love you," then violate that love; what kind of thoughts and convictions do they have about love? Take a look at the next line, sexual immorality; we could go on and on. This includes lesbianism, homosexuality, fornication, bestiality, and masturbation, among other things.

You will need to be re-educated about your sexual reality and who you are in Yeshua. Yahweh can save you instantly, but it takes time for your heart to be converted. According to the Bible, "the law of the Lord is perfect for converting the soul." Psalms 19:17.

The soul contains the mind, the heart, the will, and the emotions are the decision-making faculty. Theft and lies are in the heart, and if your heart is true, you must tell the truth. However, if your heart is not in the right place, you will lie and have no convictions because your conviction is lying. This is why lying begins in the heart, not the mouth; this is your conviction. If you believe that honesty is the only way to conduct business, you do not need to debate whether you are correct or incorrect in a given situation.

The next statement is that slander is in the heart. Slander is defined as making a false spoken statement about someone, and the Bible says that this evil is in the heart. "These people honour me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human traditions. What a man allows into his mind is what destroys him. "These people honour me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." They worship me in vain because their doctrines (teachings) are nothing more than man-made rules. Matthew 15:8-9, NIV.

Chapter Seven

Doctrine – Foundation Of Behaviour

You can go through the motions without believing what you are doing. Yahweh prefers that you act on your convictions. Because you believe first and then act, doctrine is the foundation of behaviour. The term "doctrine" denotes "rule of law." Yahweh's instructions or teachings. According to the Bible, we must honour the Lord with our hearts. Therefore, the storage of the heart is the essence of the man. You are nothing more than what is in your heart. So, what is it that you have in your heart?

How did it get there in the first place? Who put it there, and why? Where did you obtain it, and how did you get it? And what credit does the source have? And Yahweh saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. I would like you to relate this to Yahweh's statement, "If the evil source is in their hearts, then I must destroy them now, for what is in their hearts will come up." Genesis 6:5, NIV.

This is why Yeshua remarked, "The issues of life flow from the heart." So, if someone claims they love you, the first thing you should do is find out what is in their heart. So, how can you find out what is in someone's heart? Before you marry them, you put them through a series of tests. First and foremost, you inform them that there will be no sex before marriage. Then you see how they react to this, "However, if you love me," hold on a minute, now I see what is in your heart, you are not good for me. Put them under stress by telling them you want them to save money so we can buy a house before we marry. Put them under pressure, "Woman, I do not have the time to save any money." And that is why we cannot get married.

Because whatever is in your heart will show up in the marriage; We usually get married and then discover the heart; By then, it is too late, and we call it heartbreak.

Broken Heart

They say you broke my heart, but how can you break something you never had? Let me tell you something: many do not tell the truth during courtship; in fact, the biggest lies are told during courtship. Why? Because you are trying to win someone over, you keep lying. Our hearts are where the actual issues are. How many times have you heard someone say, "I never knew they were like that," and guess what, you are married to them? He has been so nice to me all these years, and now we are married.

Indeed, even Yahweh does not trust you. "You must come to me first; I want your heart: love Me with all your heart; I do not want your hands raised or your legs dancing; I do not trust any of that movement, Yahweh says. Why do I want your heart? Because you know how to put on a good show. You praise me with your lips, but your heart is elsewhere. "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind," Paul says, Romans 12:1-2.

The word mind refers to the heart in this context, and Paul is saying that you cannot be transformed until your heart is changed. Change is determined by the heart, not the mind. Transformation is linked to the subconscious faculty, according to Paul.

Do not Conform To This World

So, what is in your heart? The question is, How did it get there? Where did it originate? Where did this information come from? The Bible teaches that a man's actions are merely a mirror of his heart. As a result, we can deduce what is in someone's heart based on their words and actions. A brief examination of our communities and nations reveals the agony of children's heads being stuffed with incorrect information. Yeshua urged His followers to pay attention to what they hear and to be aware of the Pharisees' leavened doctrines. "Protect your ears and senses," he advised his followers. You need to,

- Keep an eye on what is going on,
- Read what is going on,
- Listen to what is going on,
- And stay alert.

Why should you pay attention to what goes on in your mind? Because everything goes into the head eventually finds its way into the heart, and the more you hear or see it, the more it downloads. It requires a miracle of the Holy Spirit to pull it out once it has entered the heart. This is why you can be born again in an instant, but it takes a long time to be converted because Yahweh has to change your mind. As a result, we should heed Paul's advice and refuse to be conformed to this world. The mind is the gateway to the heart. The senses are the gateway to the mind.

Therefore, whatever you do not want in your heart, do not allow in your mind. What you do not want in your heart should not be stimulated by your senses. It is that simple, and you now have control over the content of your heart. You cannot request that the Holy Spirit close your eyes or block your ears for you.

Medium

The word media means to mediate; Yeshua Hamashiach is referred to as the mediator between Yahweh and man, and the Bible says there is only one medium between Yahweh and mankind. There is only one, and that is the man Yeshua Hamashiach, which implies that if you obtain information from anyone else, may the Lord have compassion on your soul. You have not received the right message. Yeshua is not one of the prophets between Yahweh and man, as Scripture says, "There is only one mediator."

I respect Buddha, I admire Muhammad, and I thank Yahweh for Haile Selassie; all of these people are wonderful. According to the Bible, however, "Christ Jesus is the only mediator between God and man." This implies that any other messages from anybody here. Insert chapter one text here.

The Media

Media means to interpret, which is why we become so confused while reading the Bible since we are the mediator between ourselves and our understanding, and we have to rely on our

conceptions and hope they are correct. The message is under the media's control, which means that while the source does not control the message, it does control its quality, meaning, and essence. The source is aware of what he wants to say, but he must rely entirely on the media to convey it accurately; if this fails, the target audience will also misunderstand what the source is trying to say. For that reason, we just cannot allow anyone to preach to the world, and that is precisely what this young man named Drake a rapper is doing on every channel you turn to.

He is a worship leader and a dangerous young man. I saw him leading worship the other night, it was in front of 70,000 screaming youngsters. I am not sure which god they were worshipping, but they had their hands raised and were moving as if they were in church. He was cursing as they swayed with him, seventy thousand youngsters getting it on. They did all he told them to do. The media has the power to distort, elucidate, pervert, or uphold the integrity of a message. The media is the most potent tool in communication; it can either safeguard or destroy it.

The media has a significant influence on what the receiver hears, believes, and interprets. The media controls that, so we must ensure that the medium we employ communicates the correct message to the listeners, because the listeners will get whatever the media provides. In this scenario, the soul is the medium between the spirit and the body.

Chapter Eight

The Rod Of Correction

I am curious as to how these hearts came to be this way. Our children join gangs, our young girls become pregnant at the age of twelve, and our married adults beat their husbands and wives. Children cursing their parents; what type of hearts do we have in our society? If a ten-year-old tells their mother to go to hell, it signifies that the child has received the wrong information from someone. Keep in mind that this is an issue of faith.

"Foolishness is tied up in the heart of a child," according to the Bible, "and the rod of correction, not a discussion, will drive it out." Proverbs 22:15, NIV.

This implies that children should not be left unsupervised. If a child begins to treat their parents as if they were classmates, we must blame the parents since someone failed to drive the folly out. It is what is in your heart; if you spend enough time with young people whose doctrine is to curse their parents and talk back to their mothers, you will learn to think the same way about your parents. This indicates that your doctrine is becoming tainted. How did we end up in this situation? How can thirteen-year-old boys be so desperate to join a gang that they are willing to kill to do so? What type of mind is this that would kill another person? What kind of mind would tell a teenager to do something like that? What, after all, is a human being? It is just another body.

Yeshua warned us that all of these murders stem from the heart, and he cautioned us to be wary of what goes on in our minds. This implies you must pay attention to what comes out of your mouth. Television, radio, social media, and the internet, all young gangsters admit to learning from watching movies. Now, do not be naive; the Bible states that whatever enters the mind enters the heart. Then we claim that we are not to blame. What goes on in the heart comes out on the street; What is in the heart manifests in the home.

No Fear Of God

Yahweh declares that if a man rejects Him, the entire community is in jeopardy. When a person declares there is no God, everything becomes corrupt. Psalm 14:1, NIV.

1. In the workplace,
2. In politics,
3. In education,
4. In social life,
5. And in the home.

Everything comes apart, which is why we must ensure that our children are taught about Yeshua. "They are filled with terror when they do not trust in God," Psalm 14:5, NIV. There is depression everywhere when there is no God.

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To change a man, you must first change his heart. And to change his heart, you must first change his mind. To persuade him to change his mind, you must change the information he receives.

Our society's social direction is a direct reflection of the brainwashing of people's hearts and minds. Our views about Yahweh will have an impact on our communities and families. What we believe about people has an impact on our relationship with people. Whatever we believe about sin has an impact on how we deal with sin. If you do not believe in sin, you have no restrictions on what you can and cannot do.

Godless Society

Some people do not believe in the devil, and this belief, or conviction, has an impact on their actions. If you do not believe in the devil, you probably do not believe in the afterlife, heaven, or even eternal life. If you do not believe these things, your life will reflect it; eat, drink, and be merry for we will all die tomorrow Isaiah 22:13, NIV. Let us have some fun now. Everyone, including atheists, has a doctrine; they believe there is no God, and this is the doctrine they live by. The only issue is that their actions will have an impact on you.

As a result, we must comprehend the nature of indoctrination — war for man's mind and heart is the core of life. We are all indoctrinated by lies or truth; the entire media world is an indoctrination machine. Everyone is in the business of indoctrination, whether it is through a book, a film, or music.

Chapter Nine

What Is Truth

Whatever you are indoctrinated with becomes your code of conduct. However, only the truth, as Yeshua stated, can make a person free John 8:32, NIV, which is why we must understand the difference between the truth and a lie. What is the definition of truth? The original intent for why anything is made is truth. In Yahweh's book, truth is the initial reason for which He created everything, thus, to know the truth, you must return to the source of all things. So, while the truth resides in the mind and heart of the One who began it all, everyone else is lying.

God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; Romans 3:4, NIV.

This means that if you did not hear it from Yahweh, it is a lie, and if you have been brainwashed with a lie, your actions will be anti-God. This is why, as believers, we must submit to truth indoctrination; as a result, our creator is the only source of truth. Yahweh instructs you to bind His word around your neck and write it on the tablet of your heart. The tables relate to the clay tablets they used to write on when they were wet, and after they dried, the inscription became permanent. Yahweh is saying, "This is how I want My word to be received in your heart." I want you to keep putting it there until it freezes and burns into your heart, and there is no way to get it out. Put it in your heart, he added, and you will flourish.

Then Yahweh says you will gain favour and good understanding with man, trust in the Lord with all your heart lean not on your understanding and in all your ways acknowledge Him and He will give you the desires of your heart. Proverbs 3:1-6, NIV.

A Good Understanding

"Keep your heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life". Proverbs 4:23, NIV.

"The heart of the righteous studieth to answer but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things." Proverbs 15:28.

This indicates that the virtuous man does not simply react to life; he observes, and then returns home to consider whether it aligns with his values and ideals; if it does, then his response is guided by his heart. Paul is advising to stick to the doctrine; many new religions are emerging, but stick to the old concept, which is found in Yahweh's word. Stay with the basic doctrine you received from the Son of man, no matter how they come up with new things that look so up to date.

He claims that Yahweh's doctrine is eternal and never changes. Nature does undoubtedly reveal Yahweh's existence to us, but nothing is more powerful than Yahweh's written Word.

Yahweh's Written Word

Nature is Yahweh's first book; you can read Yahweh by looking at nature. Nature reveals Yahweh's might, wisdom, and intelligence, but it says nothing about His mercy or providence. How He makes it possible for us to be free of sin. Nature does not teach us about reconciliation; it is a beautiful book of God, but it does not contain Yahweh's doctrine. People who worship nature are therefore deemed idol worshippers by Yahweh. There is no motive for holiness in nature, and there is no hope for the future, no life after death. As a result, we must rely on Yahweh's other source, the Bible, for sound, untainted doctrine.

Whilst we study this book, The Bible, we get a revelation about man and life. This is the cornerstone of our beliefs. Yeshua spoke unequivocally. "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my Words shall not pass away". Matthew 24:35, NIV.

Because this is Yahweh's Word, Pilate asked Yeshua, "What is truth?" What am I supposed to put in my heart? And when Pilate asks this question, he asks it as though he is helpless. He inquired as to what constitutes truth. He acted as if he had no idea where to look for it. He has been searching for the truth, but the truth has yelled back at him. "I am the way, the truth, and the life; whoever comes to the Father must first come to me because I am the Word."

I am the beginning and the end; Rev 22:13, Yeshua is the standard and the revealed Word of God. There is no other book that has the authority to teach about Yahweh than the Bible, and there is no other book that has the authority to teach about man than the Bible. This book can help you with that, so you will be prepared for life. As a result, according to Paul, you must construct your lives on the foundation of Yahweh's Word and not accept any other form of indoctrination than what Yahweh has mandated. 2 Timothy 3:15-16, NIV.

Stealing The Word

Why does the devil react when you hear the truth? He does not want that information to enter your heart. That is why, even after sitting under the teachings of Yahweh's Word, the devil has a fantastic program to divert your attention immediately following the service. He will cause you to go somewhere to turn something on or listen to someone, completely overwriting what you have just heard in your mind but not yet in your heart. Perhaps Satan was successful in keeping Yahweh's Word from becoming a revelation by keeping it from reaching our hearts.

According to the Bible, the evil one comes to steal the Word from their hearts, so they do not believe. This is a critical statement because if Satan can prevent the Word from entering your heart, you cannot believe in the Word. Luke 8:12.

Built On A Solid Foundation

Yeshua delivered a parable about doctrine: "There was a man who built a house, and the house was built on sand, and the foundation of that house was not stable." He was discussing the Bible, doctrine, and instruction. "And as the wind blew and the rains fell, the storms rose against that house, and the house collapsed." However, the house built on the rock did not collapse. Yeshua said, "Whoever hears my words and puts them into action in his life, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on a rock." He does not only hear, but also practices, applies, believes, and is convinced by conviction based on what he hears. He claims that a wise man is a man who lives

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his life on the solid foundation of Yahweh's word. That man is a word practitioner. Matthew 7:24-25, NIV.

Chapter Ten

The Four Stages Of Habits



Habit development can be broken down into four easy steps: cue, craving, response, and reward. By breaking it into these basic components, we can better understand what a habit is, how it functions, and how to change it.

Cue: A cue is a trigger to initiate a habit. This trigger can be a time, location, emotion, person, or event.

Craving: Craving is the incentive or desire that drives the habit, which is why we are the way we are.

Response: The response is the action you take.

Reward: You expect a reward during the first and second stages.

To summarise, a need is triggered by the cue, which then inspires a response that provides a reward. This process fulfils the craving and eventually connects it to the cue. These four steps generate a brain feedback loop that eventually enables you to build automatic habits: cue, craving, reaction, reward; cue, craving, response, reward, etc.

This four-step process can be divided into two phases: the problem phase and the solution phase. During the cue and craving phases of the problem phase, you understand something has to change. In the solution phase, you take action and bring about the desired change. It comprises both the response and the reward. The desire to find a solution motivates every behaviour. Sometimes the issue arises from your desire to get something after noticing something good.

Occasionally, the issue arises from the need to get relief from suffering. In any case, every habit aims to address the issues you encounter.

Real Life Example

Problem Phase		Solution Phase	
Cue	Craving	Response	Reward
Your phone vibrates to indicate a new message.	You want to know what is in the message.	You pick up the phone to read the message,	Your desire to read the message is satisfied. Picking up the phone is associated with its vibration.

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This four-step process is not a one-time event but an ongoing feedback loop that is always operating. The brain constantly evaluates the surroundings, predicts what will happen next, experiments with different reactions, and learns from the outcomes. We use the process repeatedly without recognising the amount of work that has gone into it because it is finished instantly. Imagine walking into a dark room and turning on the light switch.

It comes naturally to you because you have performed these little habits so many times. You go through all four stages in a fraction of a second. The desire to act strikes you without thinking.

Problem Phase		Solution Phase	
Cue	Craving	Response	Reward
You enter into a dark room.	You desire the ability to see.	You switch on the lights.	Your desire to see is satisfied. It becomes normal to associate turning on the light when in a dark room.

By the time we reach adulthood, we seldom ever recognise the patterns controlling our lives. Most of us seldom consider the fact that we always tie the same shoe first thing in the morning, unplug the toaster after each usage, or change into comfortable clothes when we arrive home from work. We unconsciously adopt these thoughts and behaviour habits as a result of decades of mental conditioning.

How Do You Create A Good Habit

The 1 st Principle (Cue)	Make it obvious
The 2 nd Principle (Craving)	Make it appealing
The 3 rd Principle (Response)	Make it simple
The 4 th Principle (Reward)	Make it satisfying

To overcome a negative habit, we reverse these laws.

How To Get Rid Of A Bad Habit

Inversion of the 1 st principle – (Cue)	Make it invisible
Inversion of the 2 nd principle – (Craving)	Make it undesirable
Inversion of the 3 rd principle – (Response)	Make it difficult
Inversion of the 4 th principle – (Reward)	Make it unsatisfying

To modify your behaviour, ask yourself these questions:

- a) How can I make it (obvious) apparent?
- b) How can I make it less appealing?
- c) How can I make things easier?
- d) How can I make it more satisfying?

Have you ever asked yourself, "Why don't I follow through on what I say I am going to do? Why don't I start that side project, cut back on my smoking, save for retirement, or reduce weight? Why do I often claim something is important, yet I never manage to find the time to accomplish it? These four laws contain some of the solutions to those questions.

Knowing these basic laws and how to modify them to fit your needs is the key to forming healthy habits and breaking unhealthy ones. Any objective that deviates from the basic character of people is bound to fail.

Application Of Principles

If you apply the corresponding principles to any endeavour, you will be successful. The fabric of creation is held together by principles. Therefore, understanding the concept will enable you to handle any predicament or condition that you might encounter. Some of us want to break free from truly bad habits. Remember that habits do not form overnight but gradually over time. You must exercise patience if you wish to break these habits because the same principles apply.

Chapter Eleven

Mastering And Controlling Your Thoughts

You are inundated with thoughts all the time; in the last minute alone, your mind has wandered from worrying about one thing to another. The distraction of a text message on your phone caused you to snap back to the present, but the message's substance quickly diverted your attention and set off new thoughts. You can have up to 60,000 thoughts per day. But how many of these thoughts help you and how many hinder you? The majority of these thoughts are negative, and almost all of them are from the day before.

If we had the same thoughts every day, there would be no room for change and growth. Imagine if we could break free from the normal. Would it not be wonderful if we could shed some repetitious thoughts and make room for the latest ideas? In this chapter, we will explain the benefits of managing our thoughts and provide some tips on how to regulate our thoughts to free up mental bandwidth. Why should one desire to regulate their thinking as not all thoughts can be negative? Because our negative thoughts are the ones that cling to our brains and force their unwanted claws into our cortex. If we had the same thoughts every day, there would be no room for change and growth.

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The "What If" Train

Why is it that you get the "what if" train just before doing something important? Have you ever discovered that you are overthinking every scenario? Do you feel your worry increase as you mentally list all the things that could go wrong? What happens if I am running late or if the transportation fails to arrive on time? When we dwell on all the possible outcomes, we occupy a significant amount of time instilling anxiety in our minds.

This is known as ruminating (obsessive thinking about an idea, situation, or choice especially when it interferes with normal mental functioning), and it is a terrible thing to do. It is like pouring unleaded petrol into a diesel car; we are damaging our brains. When we indulge in catastrophic thoughts, we experience more acute and chronic pain; therefore, we must give more space to positive thoughts. When we learn to control our thoughts and think constructively, we are effectively putting premium petrol in our car (brain), avoiding physical and mental pain. When we lose control of our thoughts, we experience a brain breakdown. Rumination and worry are linked to anxiety and depression.

Regulating Your Thoughts

So, if we fail to regulate our thoughts, we risk succumbing to anxiety and depression. The only way to work under stress and not be affected is to be in control of our minds. When we succumb to negative thoughts, we lose motivation, vision, enthusiasm, and optimism, as well as our feeling of hope. In reality, hope is linked to improved social, psychological, physical, and stress reduction as well as reduced anxiety and depression. Without hope, we are helpless. We need to always be able to hope for a better life for everyone around us and ourselves, and we also need to have the matching trust that we can conquer our thoughts and take control of them.

Thought Pattern

Every thought has a cycle, which begins and ends. Cycles can be renewed or terminated. If you do not break the negative cycle, it will continue to accomplish its purpose. It can cause people to repeat the same thought patterns, preventing a new thought cycle from forming. Is there an issue or concern that keeps coming up in your life? Is there an area where it appears like the same thing is happening repeatedly? A thinking cycle can influence your behaviour. You reenact the same scenes in various settings and with various persons. The repeating of a cycle indicates a lack of CHANGE in YOU.

What is the process of thought? A thought is an unspoken word that is activated when you say it. Thoughts appear through the power of suggestion, waiting for the weakest moments in your life to occur. It does not come when you pray fervently, fast, or are on fire for Yahweh. When it comes, you can choose to accept or reject it.

When negative thoughts arise; we have three choices. We can ponder on the thought, park the thought, or reject and replace the negative thought with a more positive thought

Pondering On Negative Thoughts

Taking this approach only leads to one outcome: you incorporate the thoughts into your heart through repetitions. These thoughts have now become a part of you, leading to worry, despair, and even worse.

Parking The Thought

This means you have pushed it to the back of your mind in an attempt to avoid thinking about it. Due to your failure to address the problem, this will then continue to fester in the background and get worse. It will resurface in your thoughts, and if you ignore it repeatedly, you run the risk of being worried, agitated, and sad in the long run.

Reject And Replace Negative Thought

When a negative thought arises in your head, reject it without giving it any opportunity to develop. You think about something else on purpose to distract yourself or redirect your thoughts in a more pleasing direction. Meditation is a useful method for calming and balancing the mind. Meditation is the process of getting scriptures into your subconscious mind (heart), therefore if I read Philippians 4:19, "My God shall supply all of my needs according to his riches and glory in Christ". Now, I spend three days thinking about Yahweh's promise and pondering what it means to me. He is the source of my provision. That means that my supplies and sources are not even related to my job. I will continue to think about it until it gets into my heart and become a part of my belief system.

Chapter Twelve

Conclusion

Not all thoughts are bad, but repeated negative and intrusive ideas can be crippling; you do not have to accept this. Your thoughts do not have the authority to control your well-being. By taking ownership of your thoughts, you increase your well-being and avoid a negative mental spiral. You must be strong as a believer to remain firm on Yahweh's word and not succumb to the enemy's suggestion; you must establish an environment in which you are continuously thinking about Yahweh. Satan has to plant a seed in your mind and leave the rest up to you.

You must incorporate the WORD of YAHWEH into your spirit. A bad thought has no place or time in your life; you must rebuke it right away and prevent it from permeating your consciousness.

Hebrews 10:23 says "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for HE who promised is FAITHFUL".

You will hear negative words at some point in your life. You must respond by declaring the word as Yeshua did (Matthew 4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13; If you do not know THE WORD (the sword of the Spirit), then you have nothing to fight with.

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Psalm 119:1.

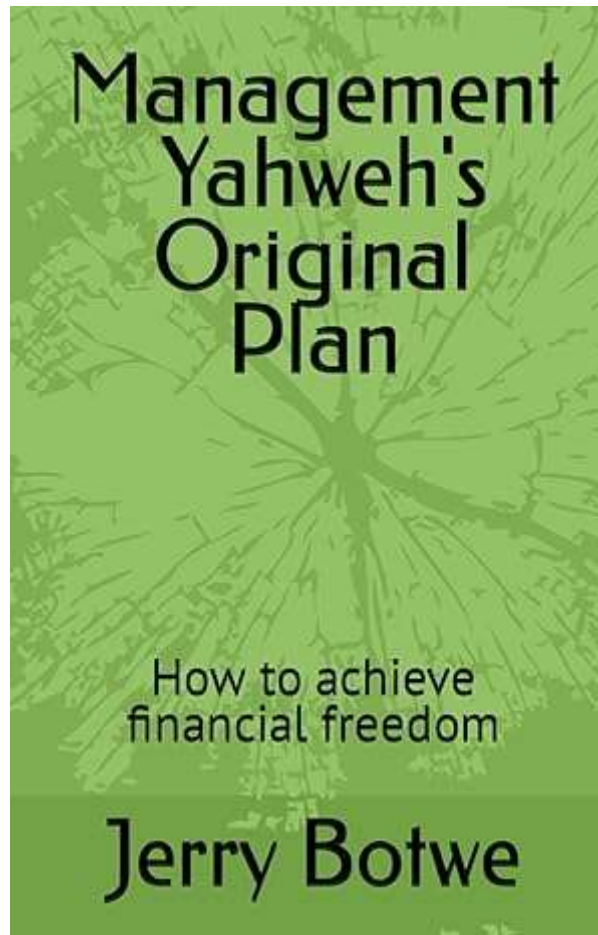

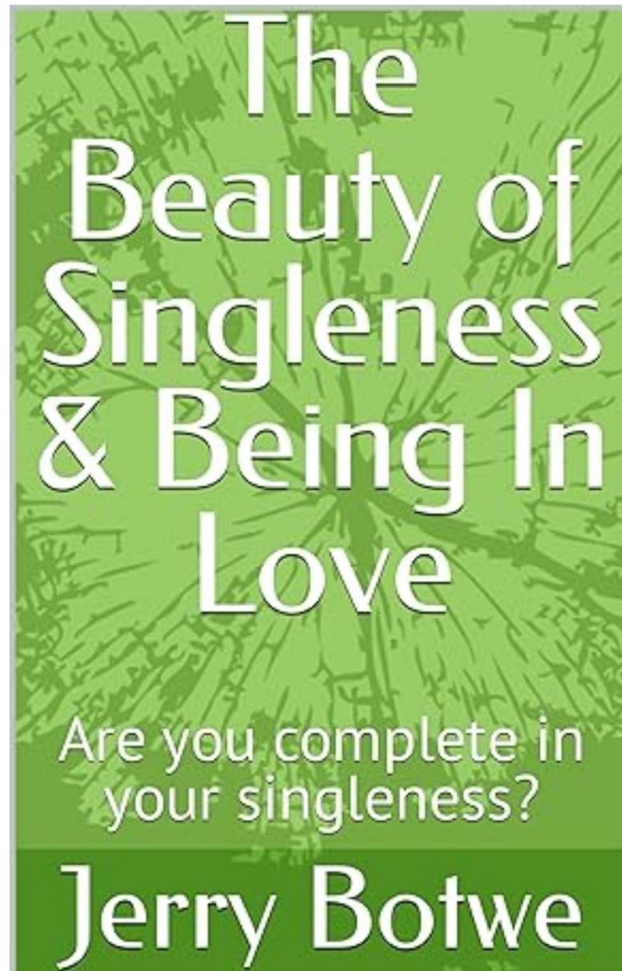

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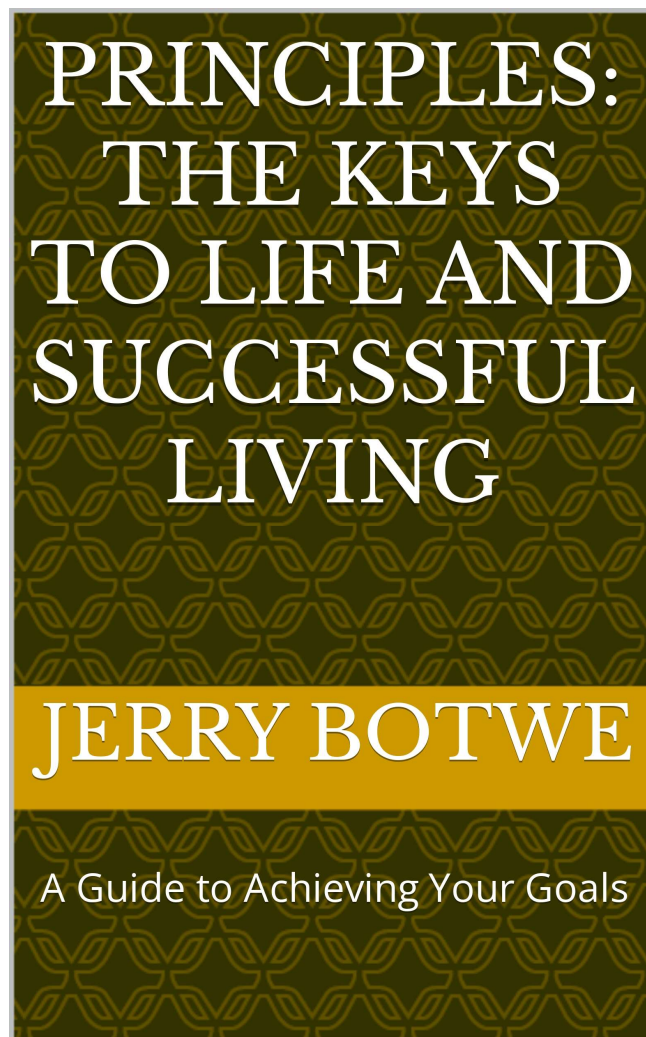


The Beauty of Singleness & Being In Love

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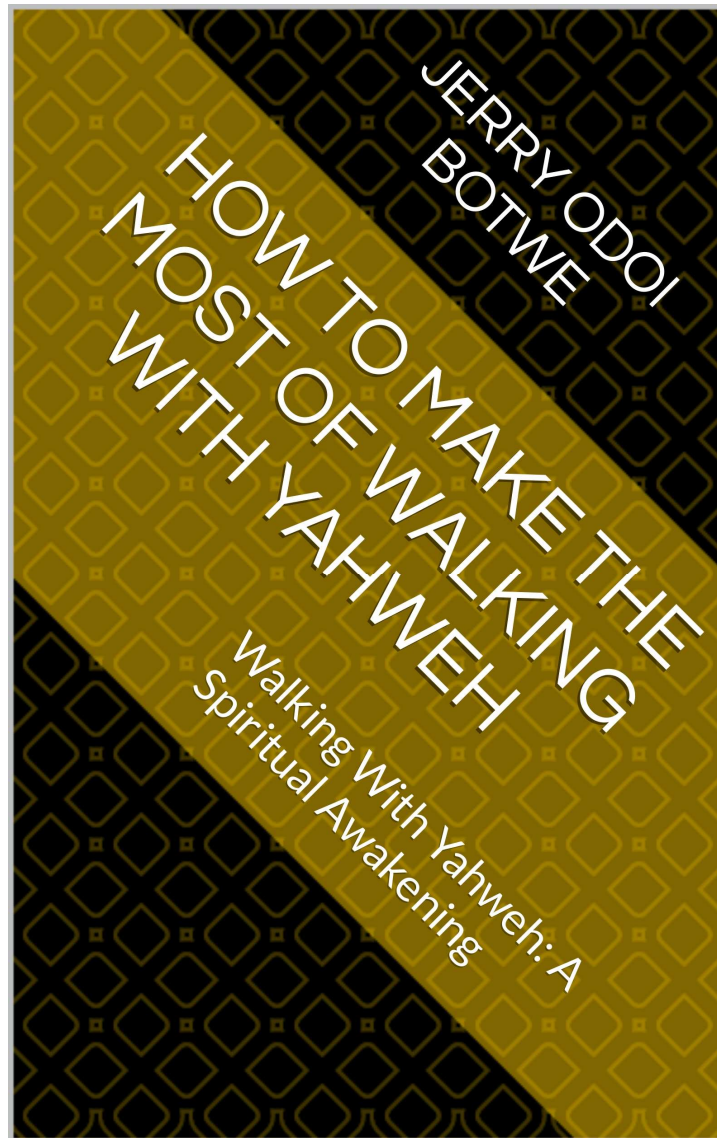

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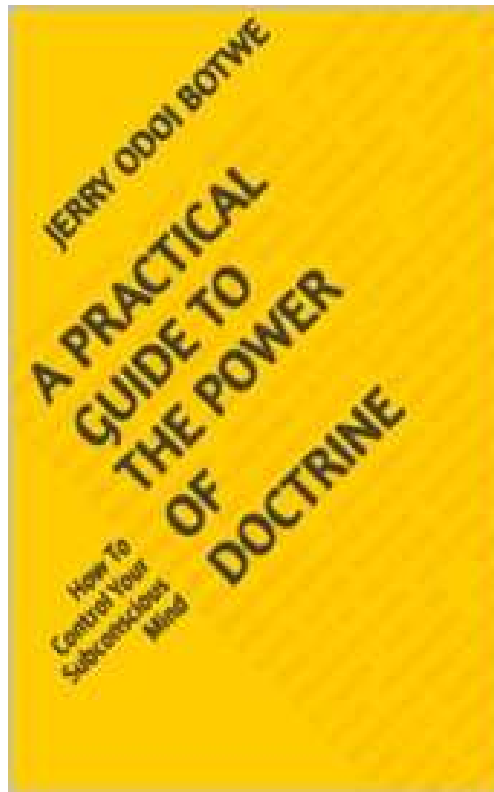
